Friends of St. Sebastian River To Clean Litter From Our River

Roseland, FL - Local citizens are banding together to tackle litter in the St. Sebastian River, as part of *National River Cleanup®* and the Ocean Conservancy's International Coastal Cleanup. Here's an opportunity to spend an hour or two physically doing something to help improve the health of an important tributary to the Indian River Lagoon.

On Sat. Sept. 15, the Friends of St. Sebastian River is cleaning up the shoreline of the St. Sebastian River. Volunteers are needed to assist in the cleanup. Youth groups are encouraged to participate. No advance registration is necessary.

Meet at 9:00AM at the south end of the US#1 bridge which crosses the mouth of the St. Sebastian River straddling the Indian River and Brevard County lines, north of the City of Sebastian. The meeting location is the southwest side of bridge opposite the small Moore's Point County Park, just north of Erling Lane. The cleanup is expected to end by 11:00AM. Participants should come with gloves, sunscreen, bug spray, and wear shoes that can get wet and dirty. Cleanup supplies and water will be provided.

"The Friends of St. Sebastian River is committed to keeping the river clean so we can protect and restore it for us - and future generations. Participating in a river cleanup is one way that citizens can do their part for the river we all love," said Tim Glover, President of Friends of St. Sebastian River.

MARINE BANK & TRUST CONTINUED SOLID PERFORMANCE THROUGH FIRST TWO QUARTERS OF 2018

A mobile shower service is coming to the Treasure Coast to help people living on the streets get clean.

George 33, a construction worker, from Texas lives on benches in Fort Pierce. There, his safety is often in doubt — and his personal hygiene is a lost cause. He said he takes a shower in a church, but only every other Saturday. He stated "Being able to have access to a shower would change my life."

George and the 3000 number of registered homeless men and women would welcome any additional chance to clean up — and soon, they will be able to get it thanks to the group CareBag Inc.

The new shower trailer will roll from churches to food pantries to highway underpasses — anywhere the homeless gather. It is now in the design stages, the first phase to gut the RV trailer has been successfully completed. Phase two is putting up the frame and floor. Phase three will be encasing and covering the trailer. Phase four will be refitted with the bathroom, electric, A/C, and plumbing.

This unit will be fitted with two shower stalls, toilets, sinks, and benches. "We are offering them these services because we know it is the stepping stone they need to regain their dignity and their life. They can eat anywhere, but cannot shower everywhere;" said Christy Romano, a board member of CareBag Inc, the group that will operate the bus. The mobile shower unit will be complete with free soap, shampoo, towels, shaving kits as well as new underwear and socks. Participants will also receive a hot meal and additional services.

We estimate we need to raise an additional \$25,000 in funds to complete this project. We are excited to start phase two of this community initiative, but we need your help. Your support will provide about 70 showers a day to people in need. 


