National and Division Required Candidate Materials: Candidates shall submit the following materials for review by the corresponding Nominating Committee.

- a. A biography/curriculum vitae or resume including current position, title, and professional background\*\*
- b. Responses to the following three questions:\*\*
  - i. What do you see as the major challenges music education will face during your term and in what ways can you transform these into opportunities during your presidency?\*\*
  - ii. What do you see as the major challenges the association will face during your term and in what ways can you transform these into opportunities during your presidency?\*\*
  - iii. How do you plan to advance equity/DEIA in NAfME during your term of office?\*\*
    \*The total word count of written response to 3.a and 3.b shall not exceed 1,000 words.
- c. An Equity Statement\*\*
- d. Leadership Statement\*\*
- e. An electronic copy of a professional-quality preferred photo (optional)\*\*
- f. No more than five one-page letters of support from professional colleagues.
- g. Candidates for National President only must supply a letter from their employer indicating support for the candidate assuming the responsibilities of NAfME National President and expressing willingness to execute a memorandum of understanding with NAfME, to this effect, should the candidate be elected.

For those candidates selected to advance in the process, materials denoted with \*\* will be included on the NAfME website, prior to a vote of the NAfME membership.
