Youth in Government is a joint program of the HEB Chamber of Commerce and the cities of Hurst, Euless, and Bedford. It was developed to educate and engage students in local government and community involvement. This program will further students' knowledge of local government and sharpen leadership skills.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE:

Applicants must live in Hurst, Euless or Bedford and be a junior or senior in high school by January 1, 2023.

Classes will be held twice a month on Mondays beginning in January and going through April.

A scholarship will be awarded to at least one participant at the end of the program. To qualify, students must:

- Participate in 85% of classes/activities
- Display positive attitude and leadership development
- Recipient must be accepted at an accredited academic college
- Supply appropriate documentation, choose two of the four outside of class options
- Complete a 500-word paper about your YIG experience towards the end of the program.
