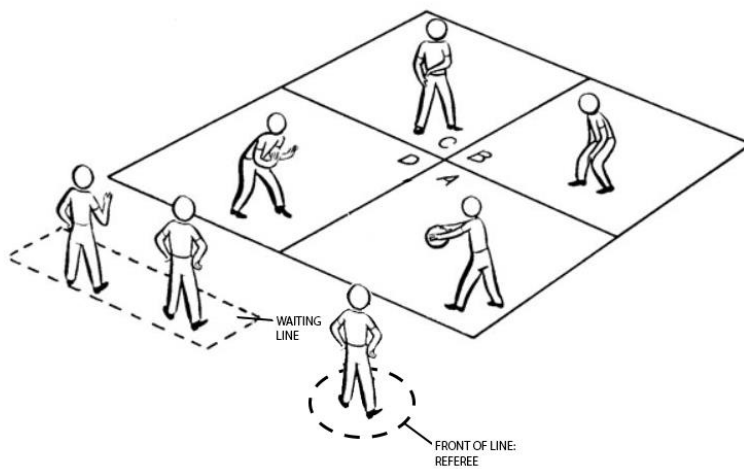


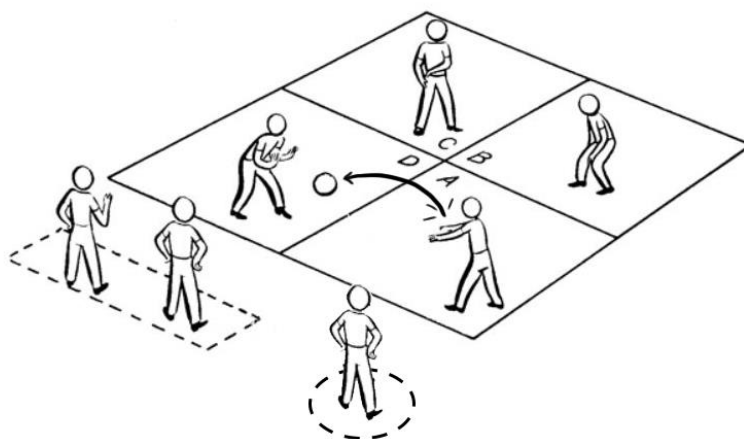
Miraloma Four Square Game Rules

Rules of Conduct

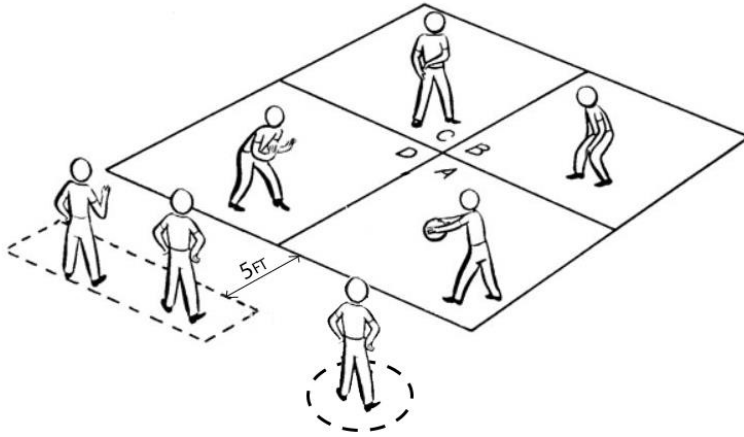
1. Front line player is **REFEREE**



2. Players on the court must use **UNDERHAND HITS ONLY**



3. Players in line at **SAFE DISTANCE** of at least **5 FEET**.



The Basics

1. Four players at a time. New players wait in line at a safe distance.
2. Start game with Square A serving to Square D. Serve must be fair, and Square D can request a redo, **only** if they do not play on the serve.
3. The ball can bounce only once in your square, and you must bounce it to any other square.
4. Players may not hold, catch, punch, kick, or throw the ball. The ball must **bounce** off of your hand.
5. Players move up towards Square A as others get out.
6. New players start at Square D.
7. If the player in Square A gets out, then player from Square B advances and becomes the new server, and everyone else advances also.
8. Players who get out must go to the back of the line to play again.
9. Differences can also be settled using Ro-Sham-Bo.
10. Referee is in charge of watching the game.
 - a. If they do not see the infraction, redo the round.
 - b. You must listen to referee's call even if you do not agree.
 - c. Referee settles all disagreements. If unable, alert a Junior Coach or adult.
