



Brad Bailey, currently of Omaha, Nebraska, grew up and graduated from Treynor High School in 2012 and UNL in 2017. Brad has played golf since the age of 3 and started competition golf in the Nebraska "Pepsi Tour" around age 9. He was later accepted into a program led by Former PGA Tour Pro, Tom Sieckmann, called Great Golf Expectations. Through this program at Omaha Country Club, Brad received one-on-one instruction from Mr. Sieckmann for 3 years until his graduation from high school. Brad played on the varsity golf team in high school and competed at the state level all four years.

After Brad graduated from Treynor, he went to the University of Nebraska at Kearney and played on the golf team for one year. He then transferred to the University of Nebraska at Lincoln and enrolled in the Professional Golf Management Program, which has the normal academic bachelor's degree requirements plus PGA

classes and qualifications. Internships each summer were required of the program, and Brad assisted with the junior golf program at each of those facilities. His internships took him to Champions Run in Omaha, Knollwood Country Club in Lake Forest, Illinois and Golden Valley Country Club in Minneapolis, Minnesota.

He graduated from UNL in August of 2017 with a bachelor's degree in Professional Golf Management and a minor in business. After graduation, Brad started as an assistant pro at Golden Valley in Minnesota. Brad then spent the next two years working the spring and summer months at Golden Valley and the fall and winter months at Old Marsh Country Club in Palm Beach Gardens, Florida. In May of 2019, Brad began a full-time job at Champions Run in Omaha, where he is an assistant pro and works with the junior golf and couples golf programs and does individual golf lessons. Brad is a current member of the PGA-Nebraska Section and enjoys competing in pro tournaments when he can find the time.
