

# Winter Wonderland Activities

## 1. Ice Painting

**Materials:** ice cube tray, food coloring, water, popsicle sticks

**Process:** 1. Fill ice cube tray with water. 2. Add food coloring or liquid watercolor to water. 3. Place tray outside overnight. If still not frozen, place in freezer.



## 2. Indoor Icicles

**Materials:** tinfoil, yarn, *Optional:* blue paint and glitter

**Process:** 1. Cut tinfoil into strips that are about 4 times bigger than the size you want your icicle. 2. Crinkle tinfoil into desired icicle shape. 3. Add string to top. 4. *Optional:* Paint parts of icicle blue and add glitter.

## 3. Water Color Snowflake

**Materials:** paper, watercolors, white crayons or pastels *Optional:* ruler

**Process:** 1. Draw lines that cross through the center of your drawing with the crayon. 2. Add small lines or "V's" onto those lines to create a snowflake pattern. 3. Paint over your creation to see your drawing!
