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What are my options for designating a memorial gift?

Select a targeted fund

Greatest Needs	Gifts are used where most needed at Madonna Towers
Benedictine Care	Supports Madonna Towers independent living residents who have outlived their financial resources and cannot fully pay for the care and services they receive
Building	Funds new building initiatives and updates to existing buildings
Chapel	Provides flowers, supplies and equipment that keep our chapels beautiful and accessible
Employee Appreciation	Supports employee appreciation initiatives
Employee Emergency	Supports Madonna Towers associates who face unusual and severe financial strain due to an isolated event outside of their control
Educational Assistance	Supplements existing educational assistance programs offered to Madonna Towers staff
Memory Care	Enhances resident programs in our memory care units by providing supplies, furniture and equipment
Resident Wellness	Supports programs that enhance resident wellness, such as C.A.R.E. Channel relaxation TV programming
Transportation	Allows us to maintain and purchase accessible vans that residents rely on to get to healthcare appointments
