# Curbside Electronics Recycling Event

October 10-14

As part of the new refuse and recycling contract with LRS, the village will be offering a free annual curbside electronics recycling event for residents who receive curbside refuse service. This year's event will take place the week of Oct. 10-14. Households must pre-register for the event by Sept. 30 and can do so on the LRS website at <https://bit.ly/3DdnwUG> or by calling LRS Customer Service at (844) 633-3577. ### INSTRUCTIONS

- Collection is free and limited to LRS/Village of Schaumburg curbside residential customers who pre-register for the event by Sept. 30.
- Please place items near the street, either loose (do not use plastic bags) or clearly marked in cardboard boxes as "E-WASTE." Collection will begin at 7 a.m. Monday, Oct. 10 and run through Oct. 14, regardless of your regular service day.
- There is a seven item limit including only one TV or one monitor.
- Tube TVs may not exceed 40 inches or 100 pounds.
- Flat Screen TVs may not exceed 60 inches or 100 pounds.
- Appliances are not included as electronic recycling and require their own special curbside pickup.
- Collection is for household E-Waste items only. Commercial or business electronics are not accepted.
- Items not reflected on the list below will not be collected. Unacceptable items will be left behind.

### ACCEPTED E-WASTE ITEMS
