Degree Progress

On July 26, 2021 we passe one E.A. to the degree of Fellowcraft. On August 30 we will raise three Fellowcrafts to the sublime degree of Master Mason. As of September 1, 2021 we have had two Entered Apprentice Degrees, four Fellowcraft Degrees, and two Master Mason Degree. Currently we have seven Master Masons studying to earn their aprons, one Fellowcrafts studying for his proficiency, and two Entered Apprentices studying their E.A. proficiencies.

The written nomination shall also include a statement from the Brother making the nomination that the nominee has agreed to accept the position if elected. 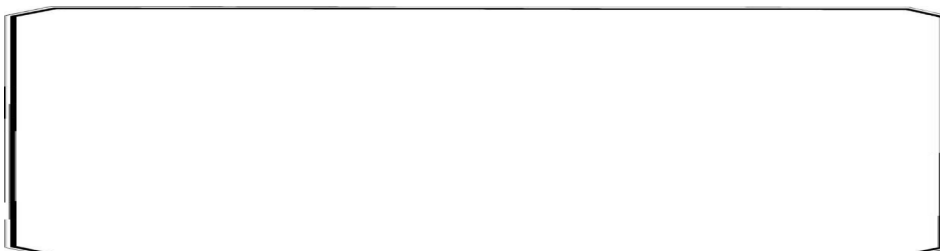

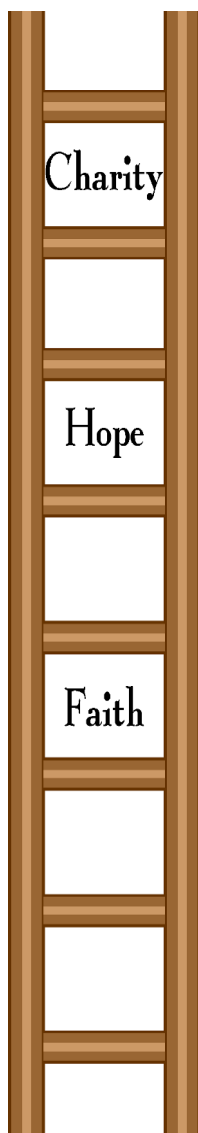
