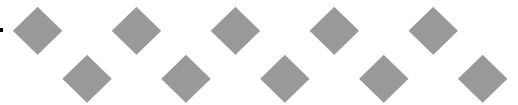
We have finally gotten rid of the mold in the Library, for which those of us with allergies, are very thankful. We hope to be finished in July with all the repairs.

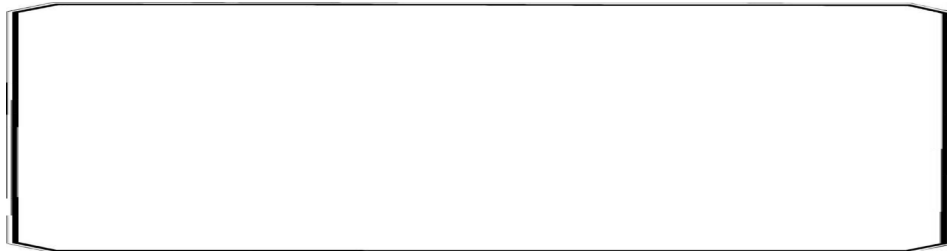

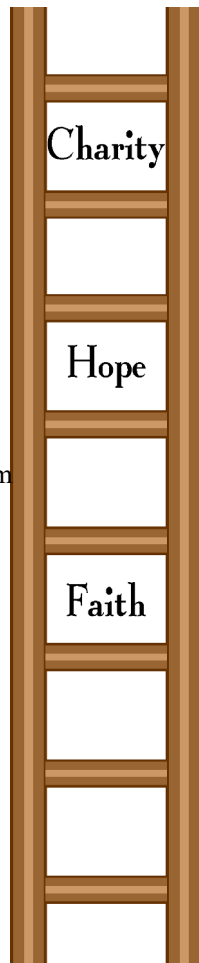
