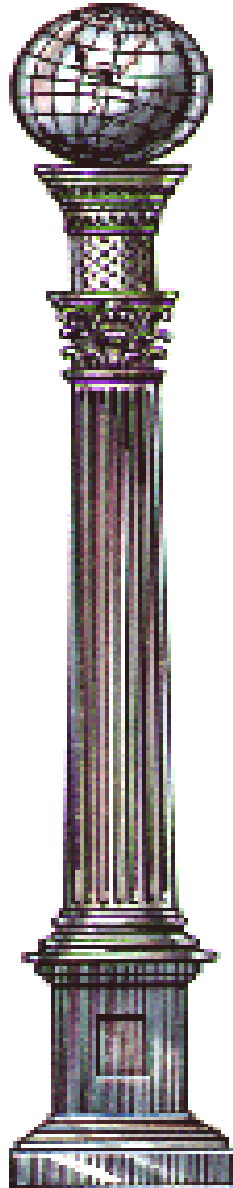
I would like to Thank all of my Elected and Appointed Officers for a Job well done this year and I wish you the Best for next year!

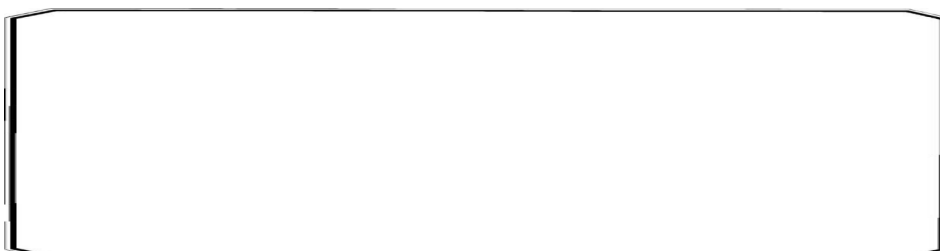

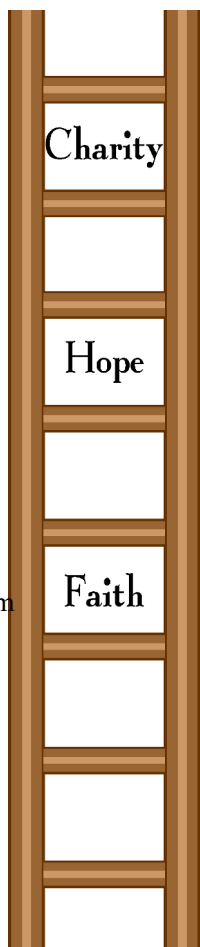
