Greetings from the East,
Hello Brothers,

I would like to thank you for allowing me to serve our lodge again as Worshipful Master.

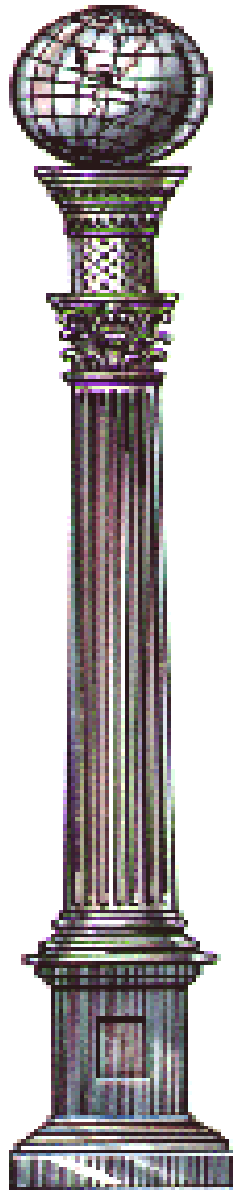
I am surprised at how many things have changed since my last term as WM. First, an example is the time commitment: Grand Lodge is stressing education for officer. Secondly, there is the stress of membership declining, impacting our ability to stay in budget, meet costs and maintain our lodge building. When our lodge had a mortgage, a good part of it was paid off by members in a bowling league, giving of their free time to benefit our lodge. Regarding membership, in my last term as WM, we complained when only twenty members attended, not including officers. Currently, some lodges don't get even three officers to open lodge. When traveling in another state, we discussed mergers where two lodges become one. I was told Grand Lodge encourages this when membership is below 80 members - as the lodge cannot continue to afford to maintain a lodge building. I visited seven of eleven lodges in our district this year.

In the past year: we have stripped the hall floor, painted the front door, replaced a few lights, replaced the lodge computer, and have accomplished a valve repair in the bathroom. Additionally, W:. Michael St-Laurent replaced the Ring cameras and installed them.

Of note: Our electric bill has increased, as have our personal bills at home. Our bathrooms are in need of a remodel, and this will be an large expenditure for us in the future - estimated near \$100,000.00. That cost includes bringing the structure and bathrooms up to code as our lodge was built in 1963.

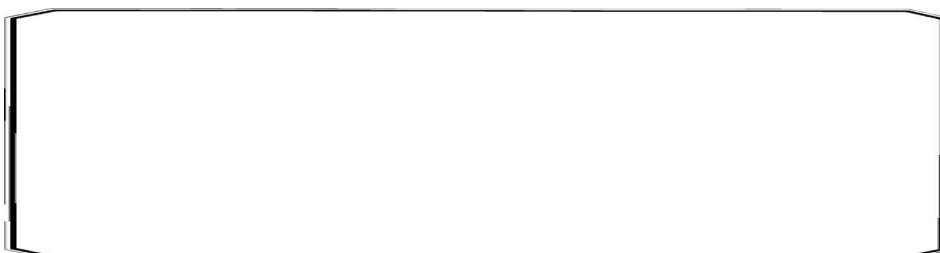

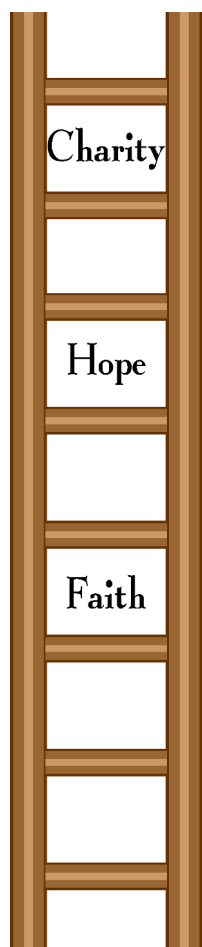
