PREVENTING EVICTIONS, AND INCREASING PHYSICAL AND MENTAL HEALTH; AND REDUCE RECIDIVISM IN INDIVIDUALS BY INCREASING PREVENTATIVE MEASURES AND AFTER-CARE.
