This 2 day Precision Rifle course is designed to give all participants, regardless of background, the solid foundation and knowledge required to consistently and safely engage targets at extended distances with a precision rifle. Through consistency and proper mindset, the student will be taught how to select the proper equipment for the intended use, how to setup that equipment, and eventually how to execute the proper fundamentals of precision shooting.

Day one of the course will focus on familiarizing the students with their equipment, support gear commonly used during precision shooting, as well as developing the proper fundamentals of precision marksmanship. Some of the topics covered will be, reticle management, natural point of aim (NPOA), recoil control, proper use of elevation and windage turrets, use of holdovers, ballistic computer setup, external ballistics, environmental factors as they apply to external ballistics, and wind. By end of day all students will have true DOPE (data on previous engagement) for their gun out to 500 yards. Day one is all shot from prone, **not from a seated bench position.**

Day two, will focus on alternate position shooting, meaning positions other than prone while still reinforcing the principals learned during day one, including multiple targets. Additionally, students will be introduced to the formula needed to measure range and effectively engage unknown distance targets.

Additionally, this course is limited to calibers of .300 Win Mag and below

Materials Required to participate:

- Scoped Precision Rifle (With A Ballistic Reticle (Mil, MOA, Or BDC))
- Minimum Of 1 Magazine (ADDITIONAL MAGAZINES RECOMMENDED)
- Minimum 100 Rounds Of Match Ammunition
- Eye/Ear Protection
- Small Rear Stock Bag (Preferably A Bag That Can Be Easily Molded, Not A Hard Bag)
- Bi-Pod Or Bag To Support Front Of The Rifle
- Shooting Mat
- Chamber Flag(You May Purchase Flag In Office If You Do Not Have One)
- Notepad & Pen
- Ballistic Computer, i.e, phone App
- Kestrel Weather Meter(If You Use One)
- Logbook(If You Use One)
- Any Spare Part Or Tools You Think You May Use Or Need For Your Scope Or Rifle
- Batteries For Any Electronics Used
