COVID-19 Protocols for High School REGROUP

Face Coverings, Social Distancing, and Hand Sanitizer

- All students and leaders **must wear a face mask or face shield** (even if they are vaccinated) while attending student ministry gatherings. Pastor Eric will let you know when / if it is okay to remove your mask.
- Students will be **seated three feet apart** during the service and in their small groups.
- Hand sanitizer stations are set up around the Calvary Life Center to provide access quickly and frequently.

Check-In

- **Upon entering the CLC through the MAIN ENTRANCE, students must check in with a Student Ministry volunteer.** As students arrive, they should tell the leader at check-in their name and grade.
- Guests will need to complete a "Guest Card" with their personal information. A leader will be assigned to fill out the card while asking the student/parent for the correct information.

Temperature Checks

- Before entering the common area, we will be taking temperatures of each student/leader/parent to ensure that no one has a fever. If a temperature check reads 100.4 or higher, we will wait 5 minutes and re-check. If it is the same or higher, that individual will not be permitted to enter the facilities.

Dismissal

- **Students will be dismissed at 8:00 PM.** We ask our students to exit the CLC upon dismissal.

Symptoms, Exposure, and Positive Test Protocol for Return to Ministry Events

Students/Leaders who have symptoms, have been exposed to COVID-19, or have tested positive for COVID-19 must follow the procedures outlined below.

Have Symptoms

- Anyone who is showing symptoms of COVID-19, or any sickness at all, **MUST NOT ATTEND** any Calvary Student Ministry on-campus programming.
- Sick individuals should quarantine and contact his/her health provider to seek direction.

Exposed to Individual with Positive COVID-19

- **If you have been exposed to an individual with COVID-19**, then students/leaders **MUST NOT ATTEND** programming.

Test Positive for COVID-19

Before you can return to the ministry programming, you must:

- Have a “negative” test result
- Be symptom-free
- AND, 14 days must have passed since symptoms first appeared

COVID-19 Symptoms

The CDC and other health organizations currently list the following symptoms:

- Fever (100.4 and above)
- Chills
- Shortness of Breath
- Cough
- Loss of taste/smell
- Nasal Congestion/Runny Nose
- Diarrhea
- Fatigue
- Nausea/Vomiting
- Headache
- Muscle or body aches
