Text: Colossians 4:2

Big Idea of the Message: Big Prayers

Application Point: Instructions for our prayer lives

Questions from the Text:

1. How can our speech help or hinder what the world thinks about Christians?
2. Do you pray more for specific things or are your prayers more general?
3. Do you make more requests of God in your prayers than you do thanking Him when you pray?
4. How can you pass down a legacy of prayer to your family and the next generation?

Challenge from the Sermon:

1. To be “devoted” to prayer also means to be “ready at all times.” How are you preparing yourself for each day when you pray?
2. Watchful prayer provides the spiritual fortitude to face down temptation. What are you watching for and how can you be ready for Satan’s attack?
3. There are at least two things we should say when we pray: Ask for open doors and ask for clarity. Which one do you need right now?
4. Share your prayer for open doors and clarity with others. Be real and transparent.
