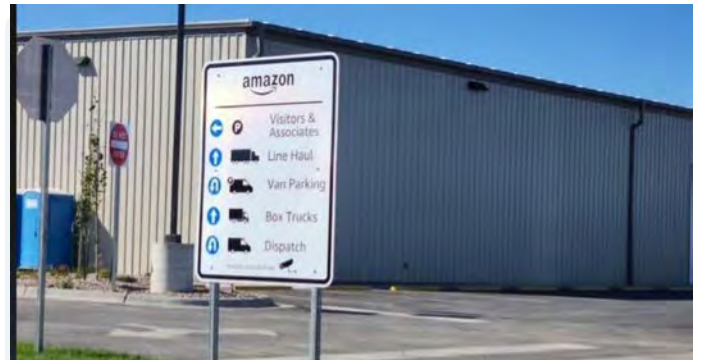

A \$150,000 Growth Through Agriculture grant helped Treasure State Sires open Montana's first boar stud facility near Cascade. With application support from GFDA's Food & Ag Development Center, the Cascade Colony facility will house about 400 boars and produce more than 100,000 genetic samples annually for pork producers nationwide.

Big Sandy Organics

GFDA provided \$165,000 in gap financing to help Big Sandy Organics complete a \$4 million expansion of its Kracklin' KAMUT production operation. New automated equipment will significantly increase production capacity and help the Montana-grown company pursue new markets, including international sales.
