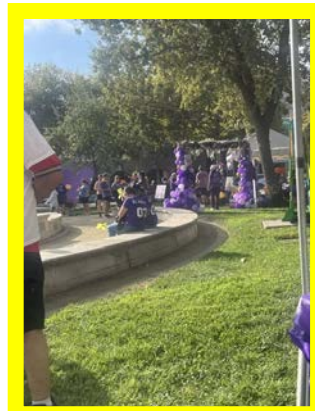

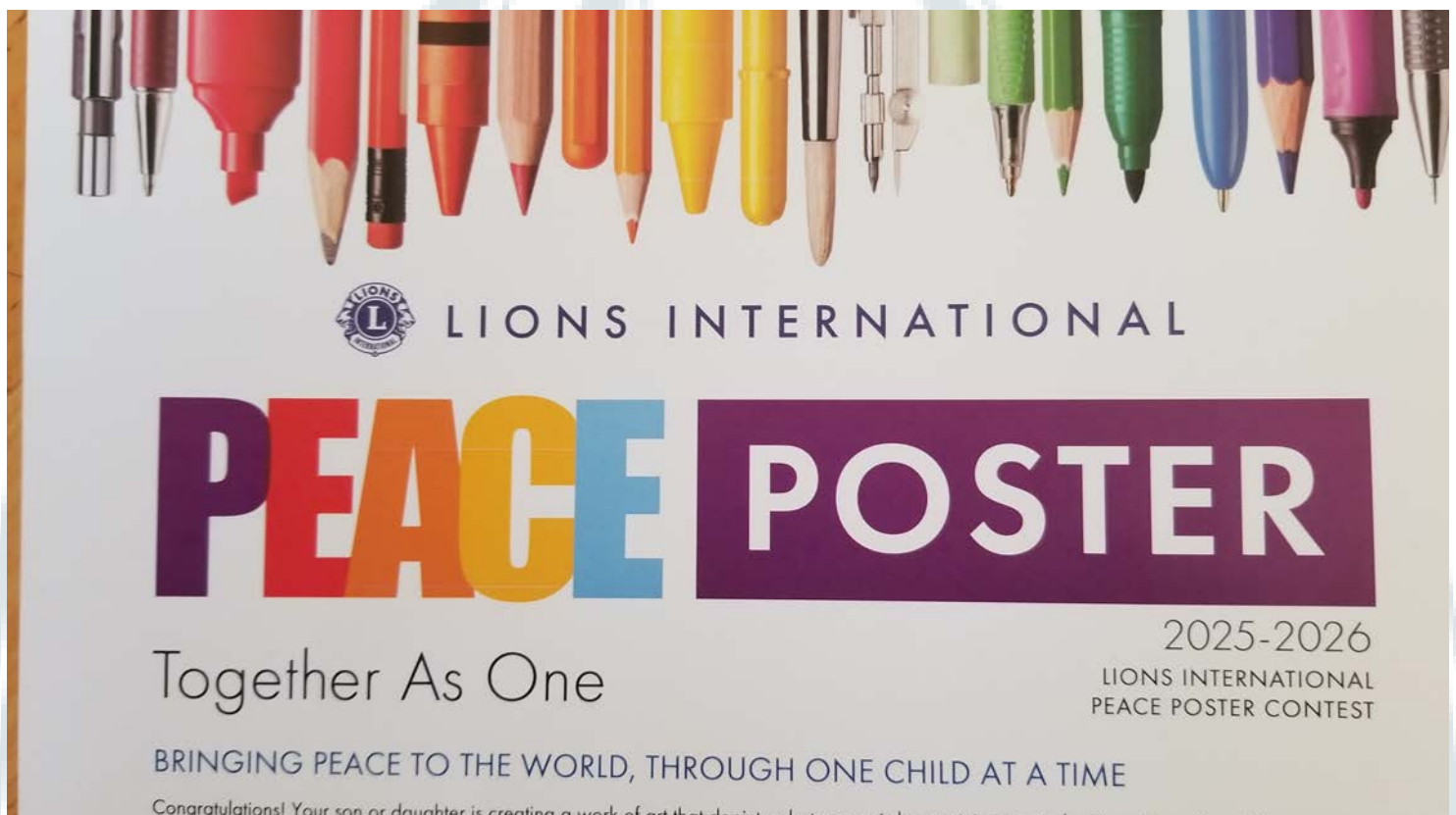
Peace Poster Contest


