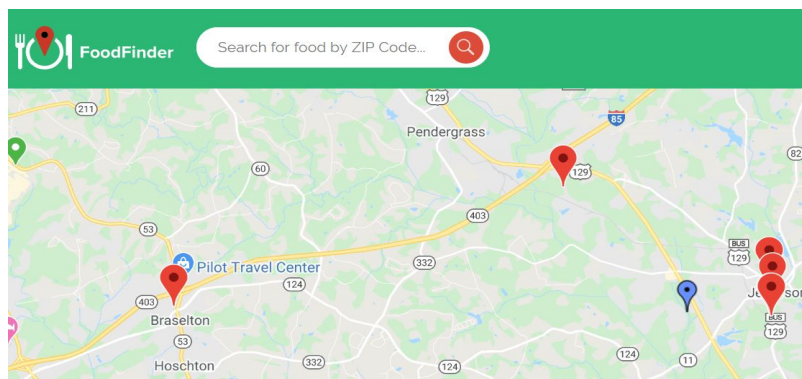


## Food Providers

- **FoodFinder** ([foodfinder.us](http://foodfinder.us)) is a safe, secure and award-winning mobile and web app that gives food insecure children and their families a way to find free food assistance programs quickly.
  - How to get started:
    - Enable your location
      - This will let us determine your location in relation to the free food providers.
      - If you denied location access already, just reload the page and approve it.
    - Multiple pins will be visible
      - The blue pin is **you** and red pins are free food providers.
    - Select a location
      - Clicking on a red pin and then the name of the free food provider will list all the info we have on that provider

Families can visit up to 12 times per year for free and every time after that is \$5.

- **Charter Spectrum for Students** ([spectrum.com](http://spectrum.com))
  - Households with students K–12 or university students can sign up for a new Charter Spectrum internet account to get the first two months of internet with speeds up to 100 Mbps for free. Installation fees will be waived for those who qualify for the offer. Call 1-844-488-8395 to enroll.
