The final class includes a special audition with Jeff Church, Coterie Producing Artistic Director, or a member of The Coterie staff, for youth roles in the upcoming Coterie season.

## PERFORMANCE CAMPS

### THE RULES OF COMEDY (THE STAGE PLAY!)

#### One Week Performance Camp at Liberty

#### Incoming Grades 5-10

Actors will flex their funny bones by giving the audience a side-splitting lesson on what's funny and what's not funny. To prove their points, the rules are hilariously inserted into one of the most popular tragedies of all time: William Shakespeare's *Hamlet*. *The Rules of Comedy* is full-blown physical comedy with an interesting twist that showcases the cast's ability to handle tragic drama as well. Playing by the rules has never been so much fun! All students enrolled will have a speaking role—some large and some small. ### WAR OF THE WORLDS

#### Two Week Performance Camp at Pembroke Hill

#### Incoming Grades 9-12

### IN-PERSON REHEARSAL WITH VIRTUAL PERFORMANCE
