St. John's Episcopal Church, Chula Vista, CA offers annual scholarships of \$500.00 – \$2,000.00 to high school seniors who are active members of St. John's Episcopal Church, a family member of a parishioner, or a member of a parish within the Episcopal Diocese of San Diego who has met the following requirements and has been selected by the scholarship committee.

Eligibility: Active member of St. John's Episcopal Church, Chula Vista, CA, family member of a parishioner or member of a parish in the Episcopal Diocese of San Diego, and a senior at one of the area high school districts.

Requirements:

- Completed Application
- Essay
- Statement of Faith
- Letter of Recommendation
- Copy of Unofficial High School Transcript -- Overall GPA no lower than 2.5
- Copy of Letter (or proof) of Acceptance (at a college, school, or institute of learning)

Completed application packets and essays must be turned in to the church office of St. John's Episcopal Church no later than **Thursday, April 24, 2025, 4:00 PM** to be considered for a scholarship.
