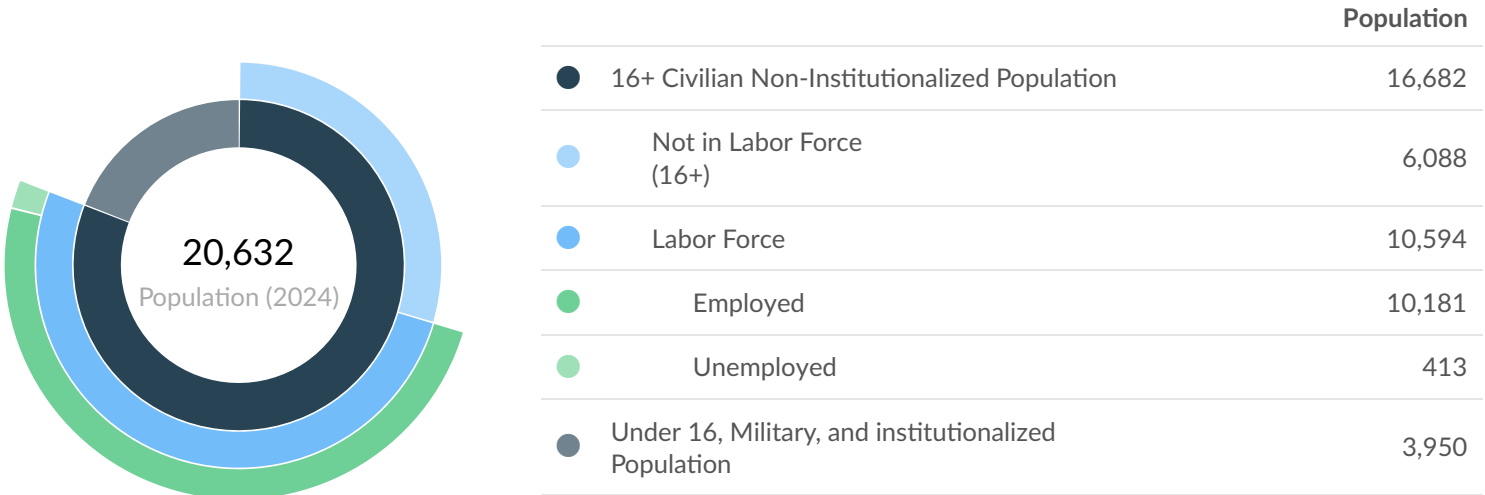

- As of 2023 the region's population **increased by 1.6%** since 2018, growing by 317. Population is expected to **increase by 1.4%** between 2023 and 2028, adding 292.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs **increased by 3.8%** in Carroll County, IN from 6,341 to **6,584**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 4.5% by 0.7%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 62.4% to 61.9% between 2018 and 2023**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **10.9% of Carroll County, IN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.3% below the national average), and **11.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Animal Slaughtering and Processing, Other Food Manufacturing, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).

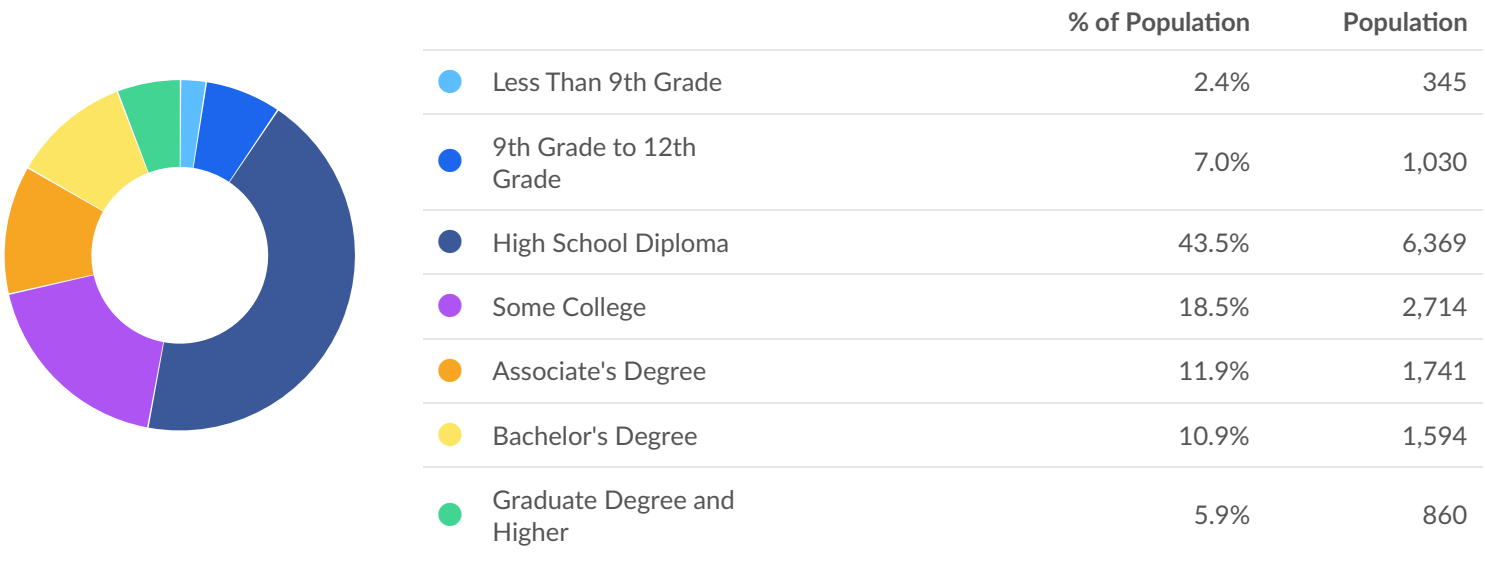

Sep 2024 Labor Force Breakdown



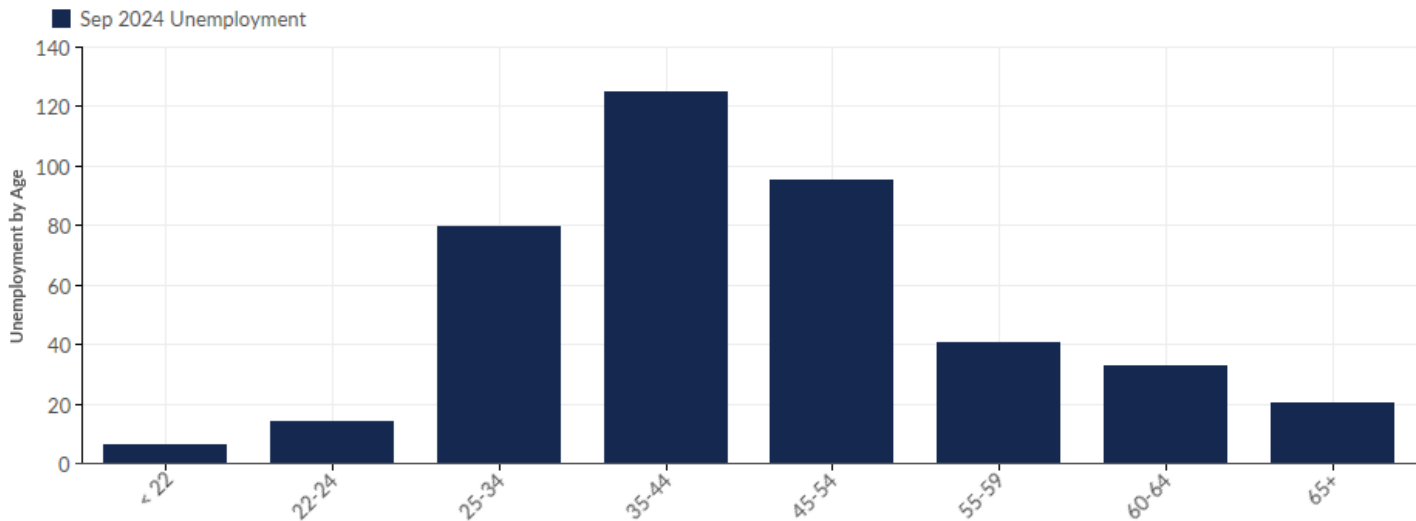
Educational Attainment

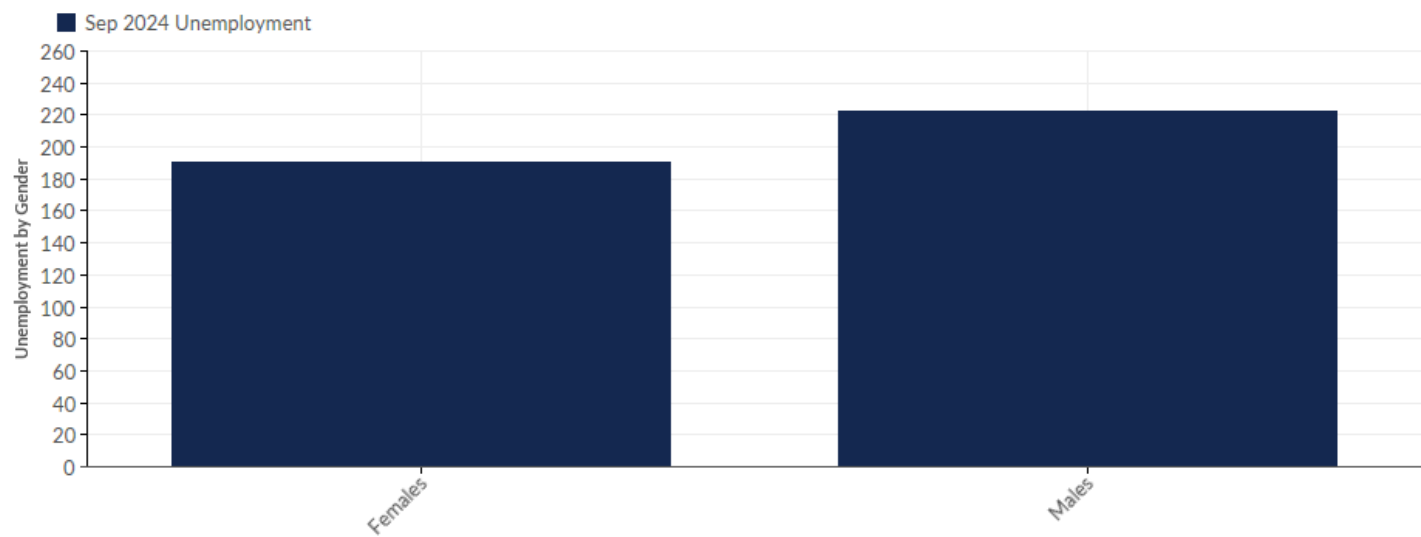

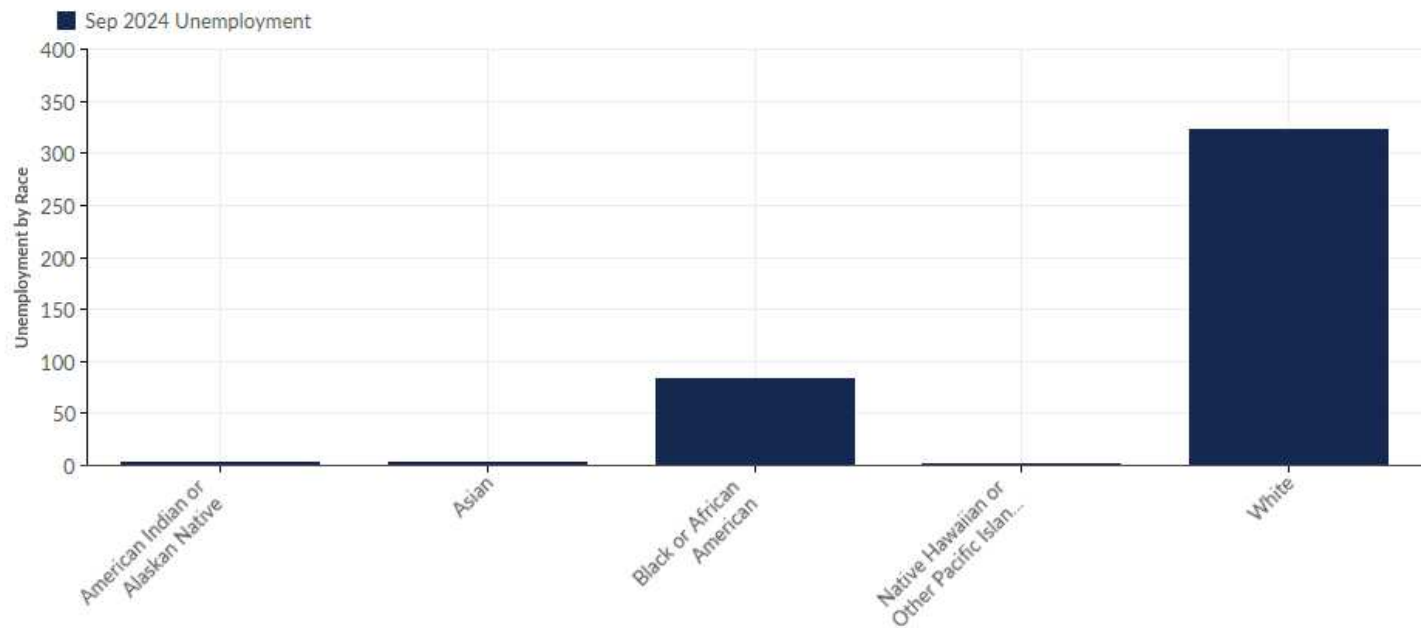

Unemployment by Gender



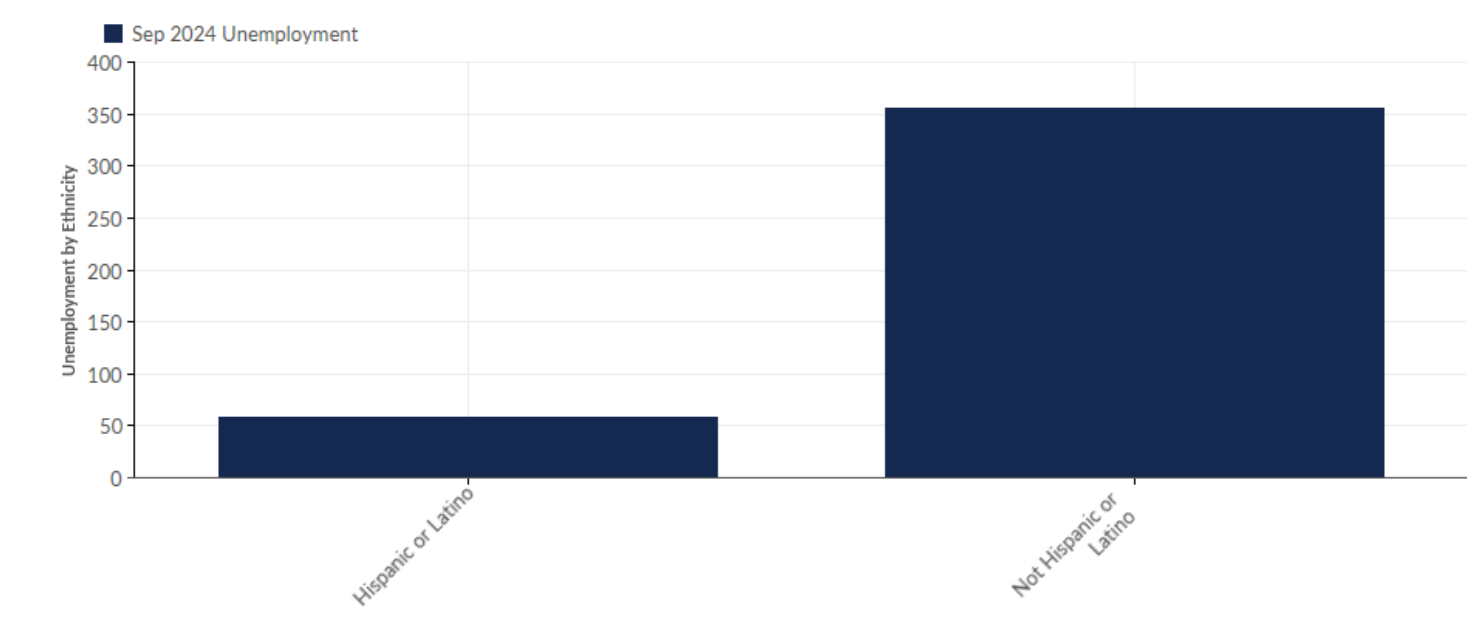

Unemployment by Ethnicity

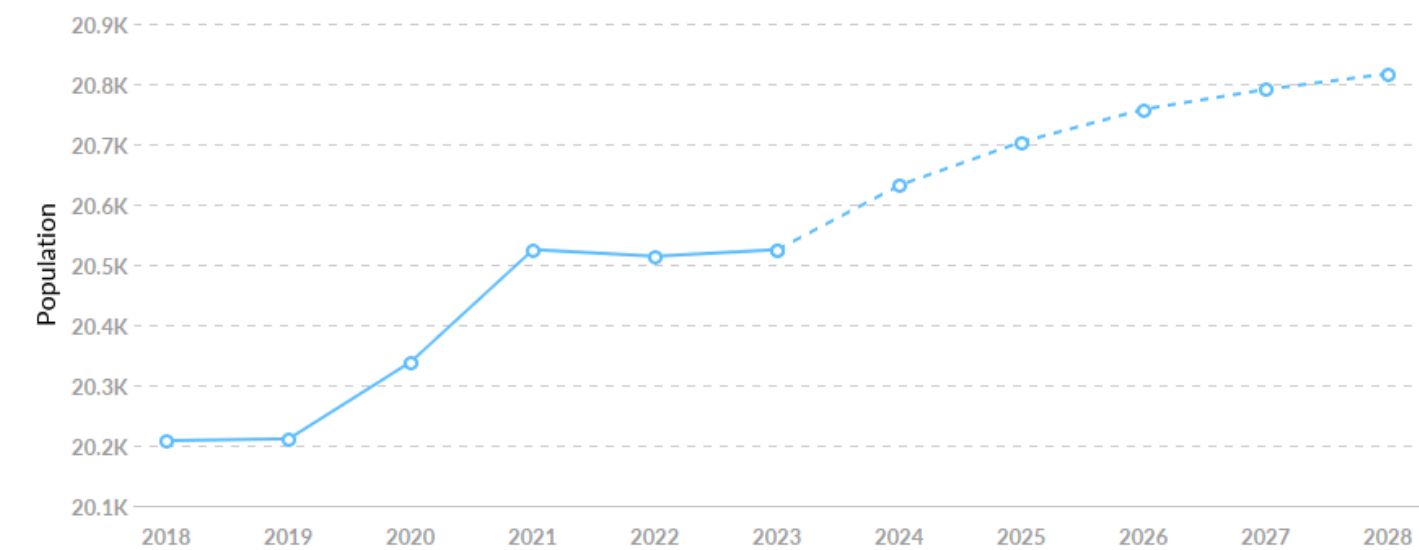

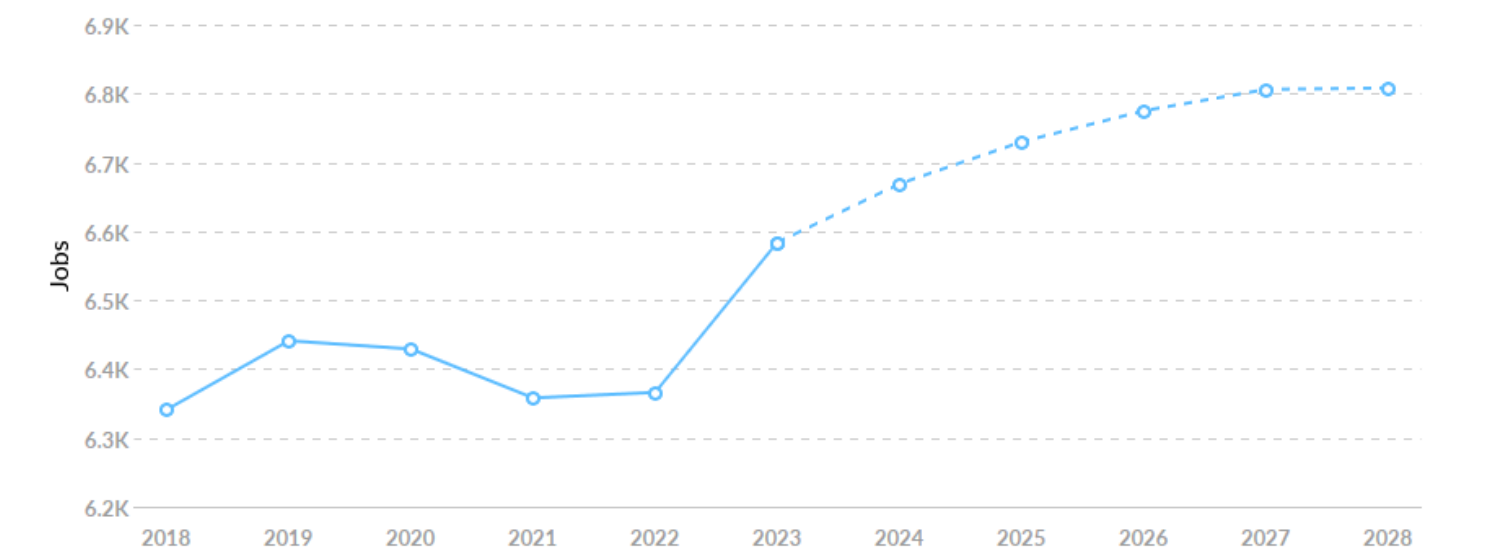

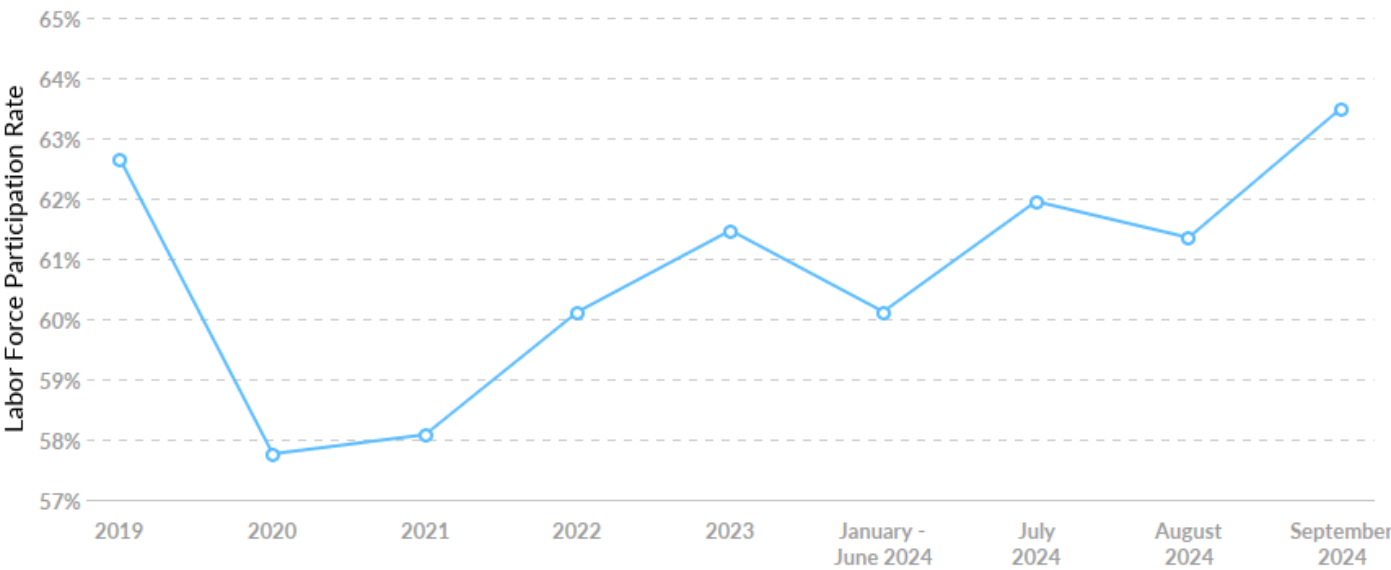
Job Trends

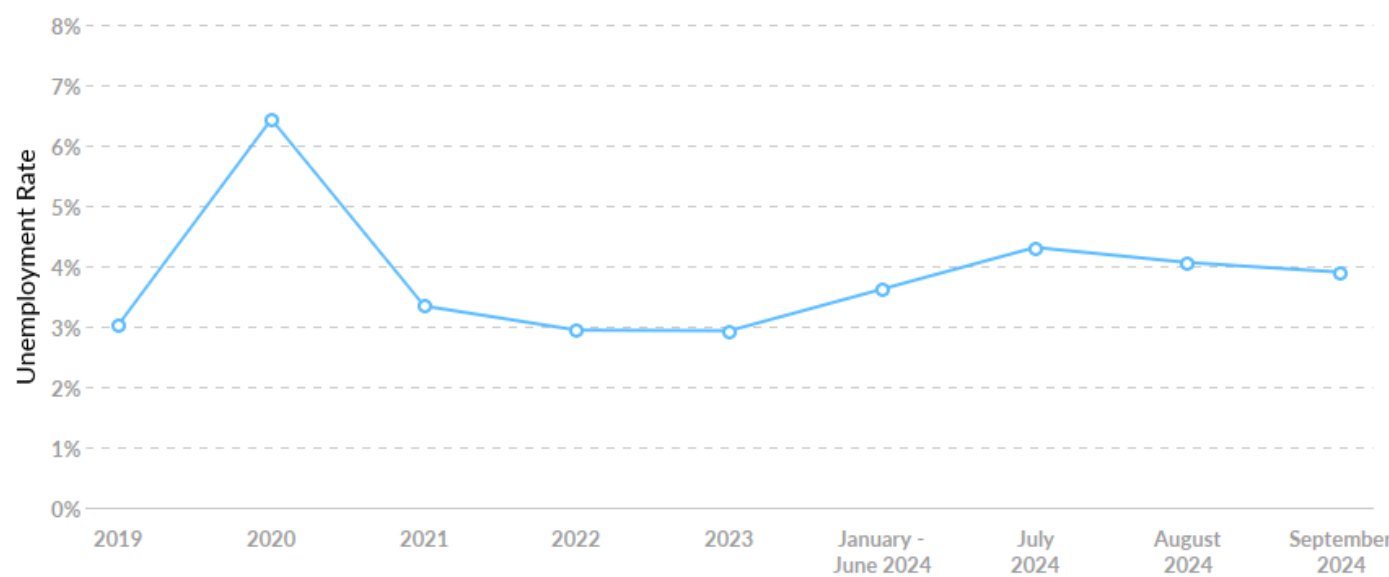

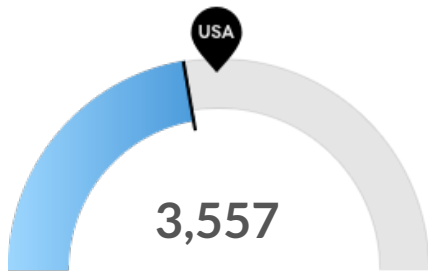
Unemployment Rate Trends

Carroll County, IN had a September 2024 unemployment rate of 3.90%, **increasing from 3.03%** 5 years before.



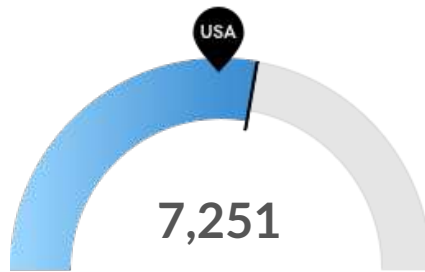

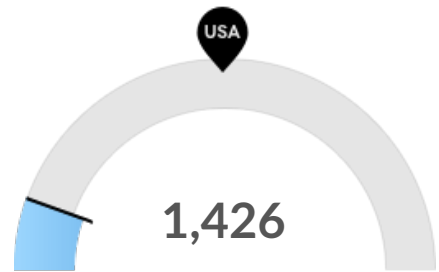
Millennials

Carroll County, IN has 3,557 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,170.



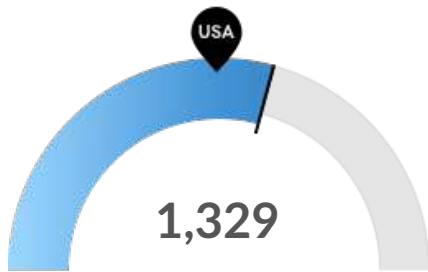
Retiring Soon

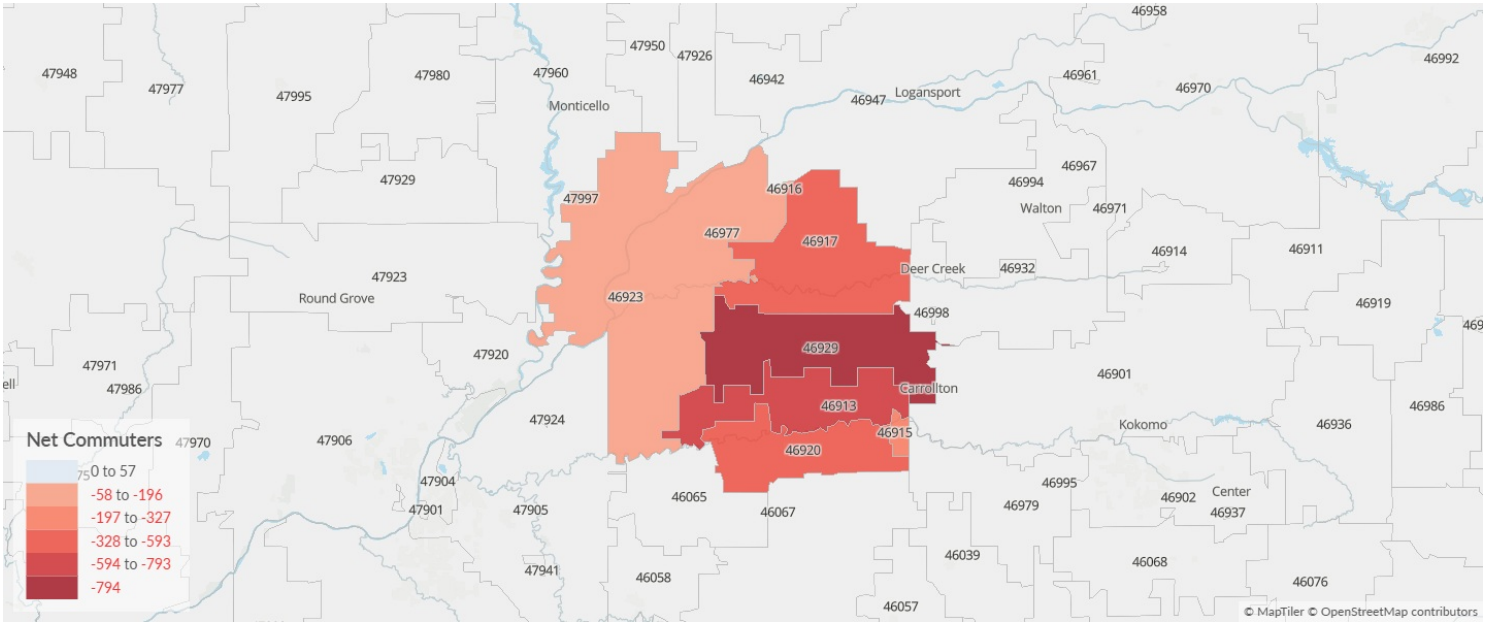

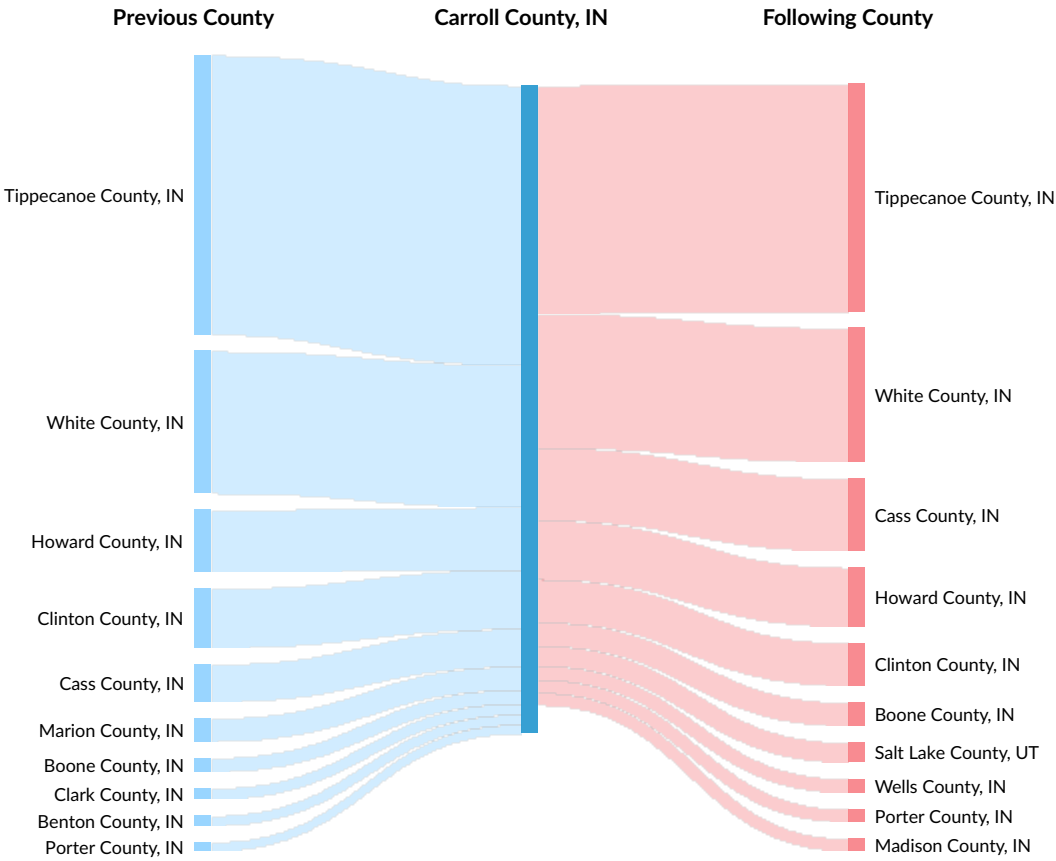

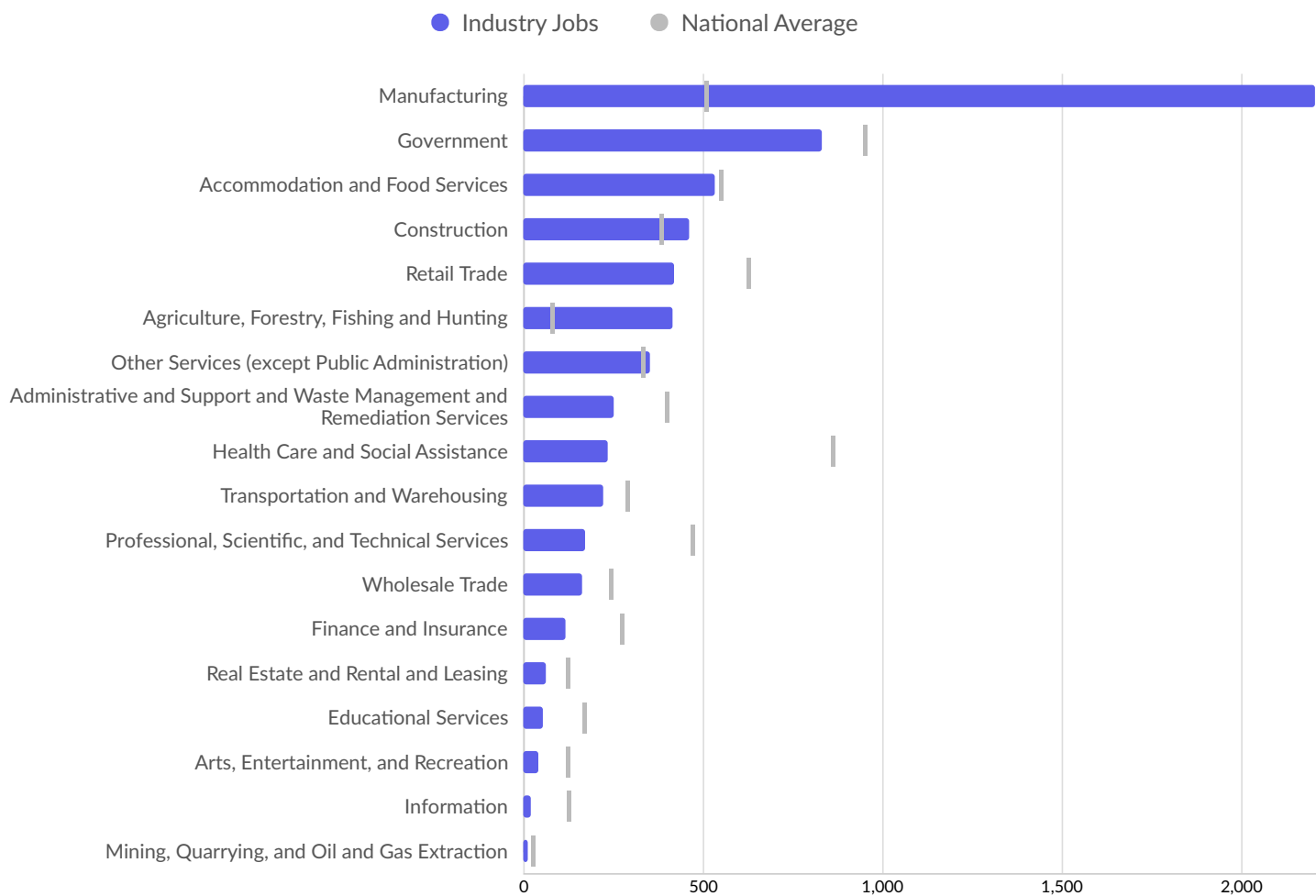

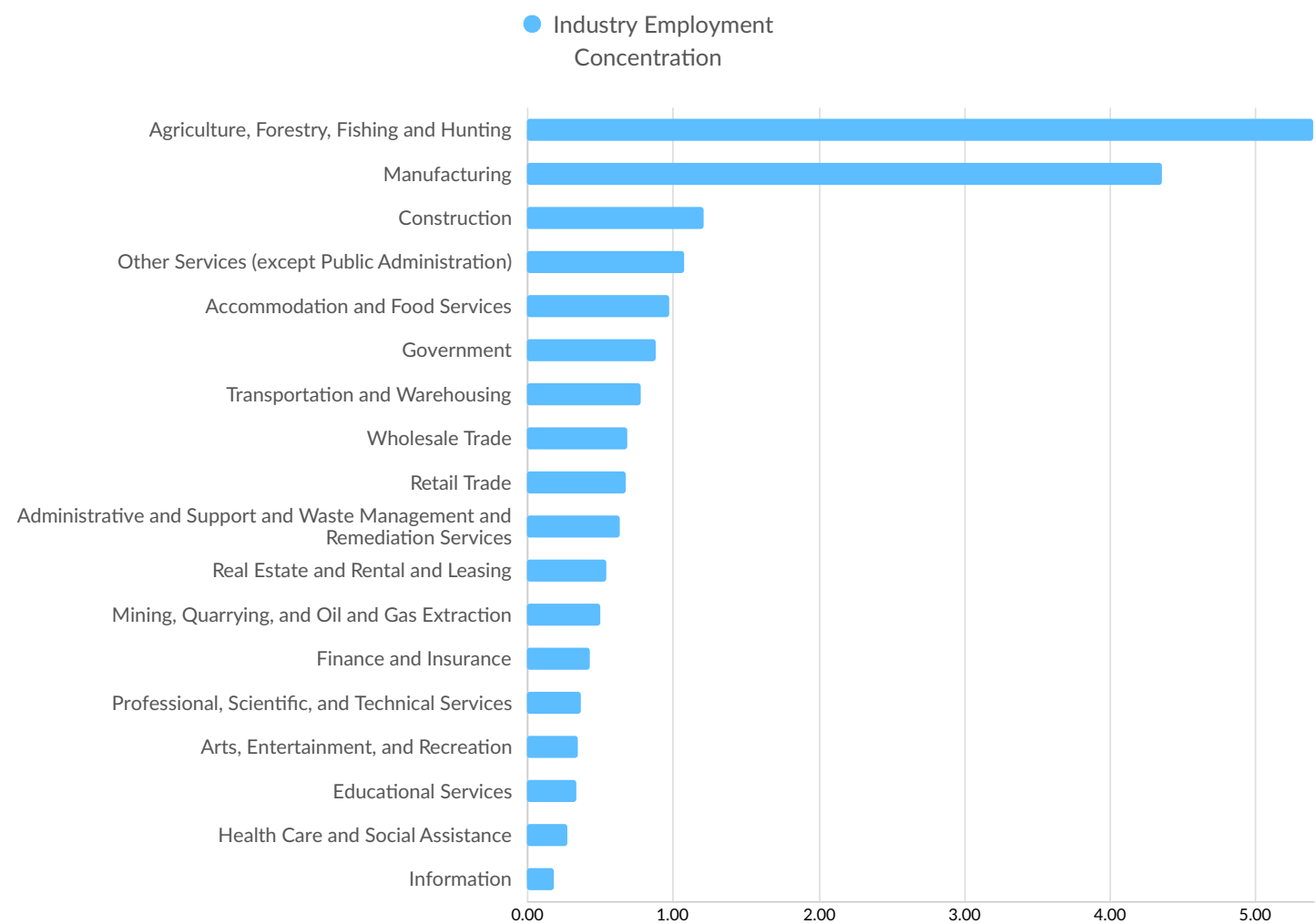

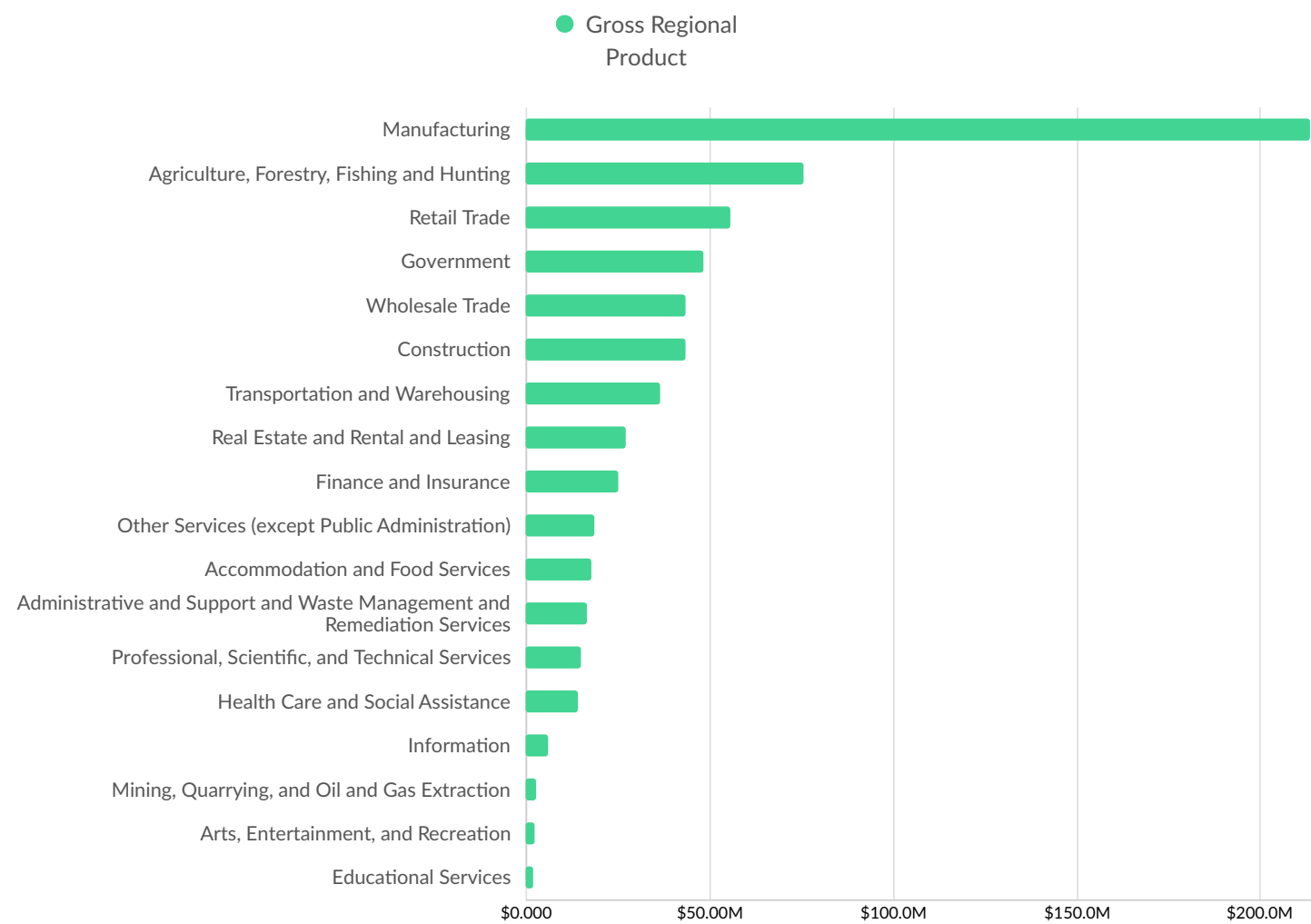
Top Growing Industries

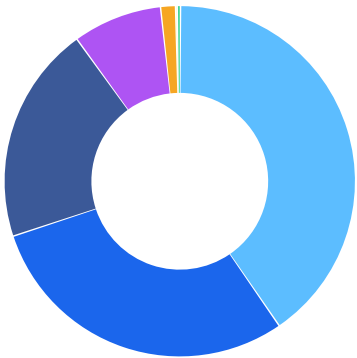

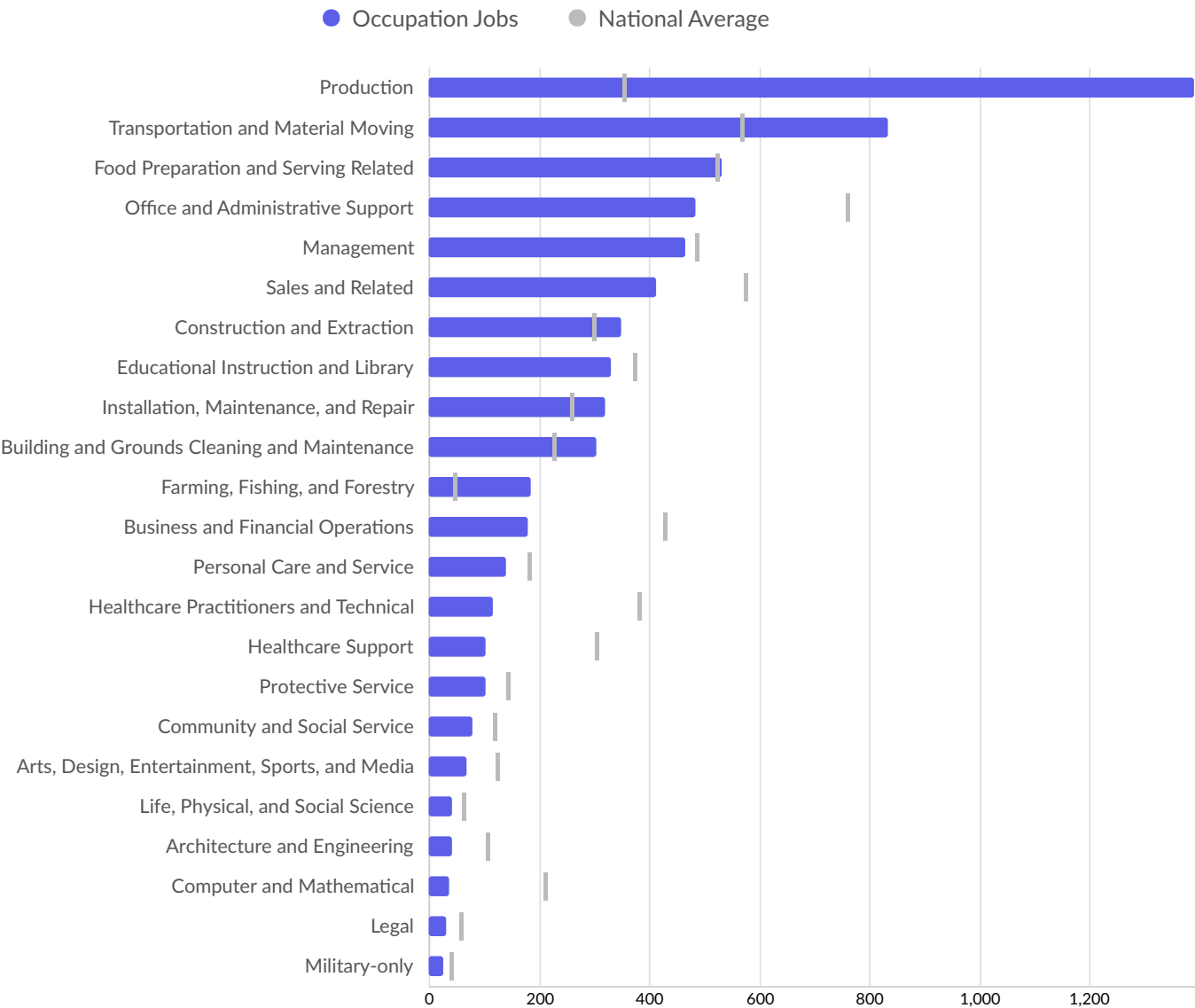

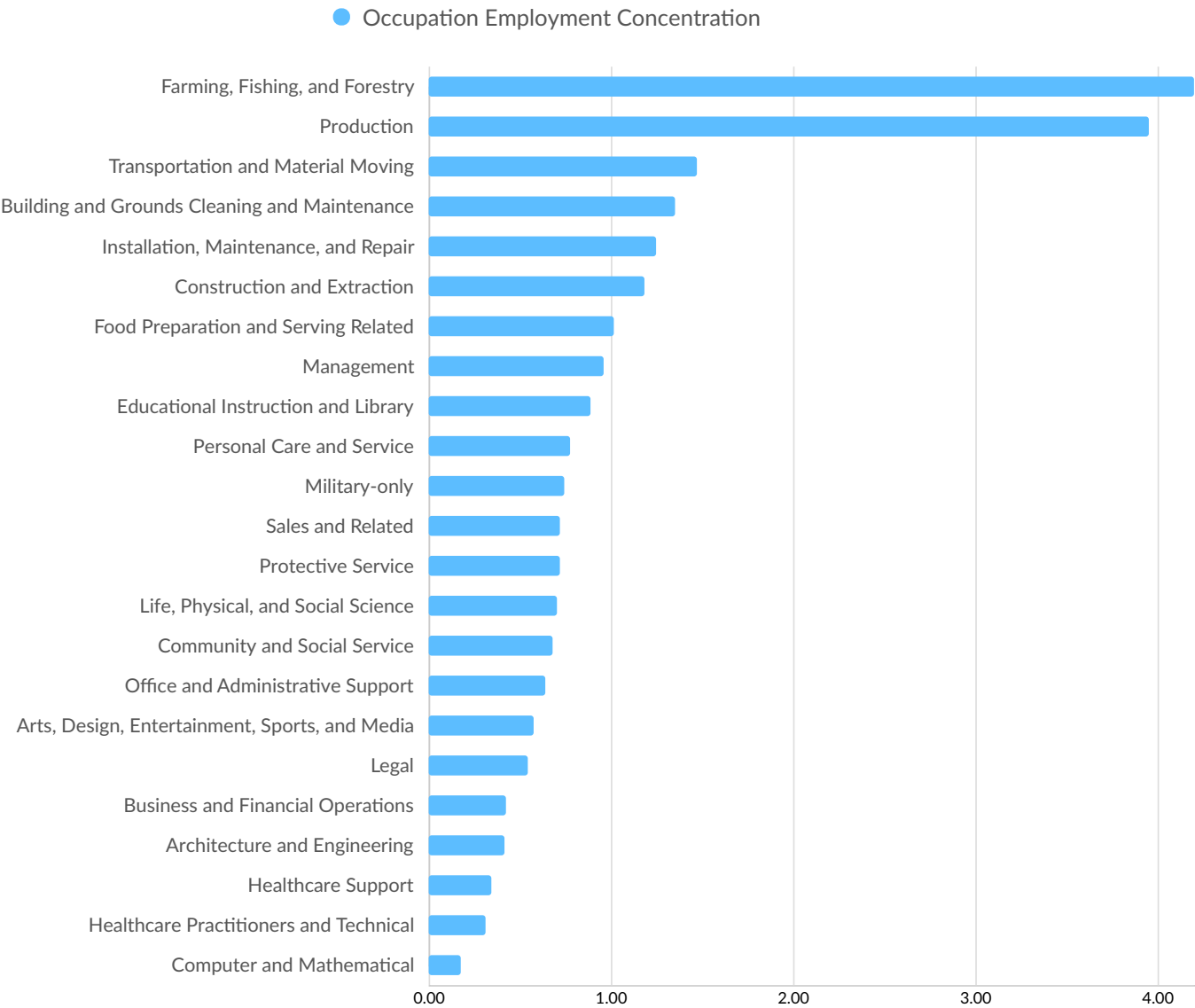

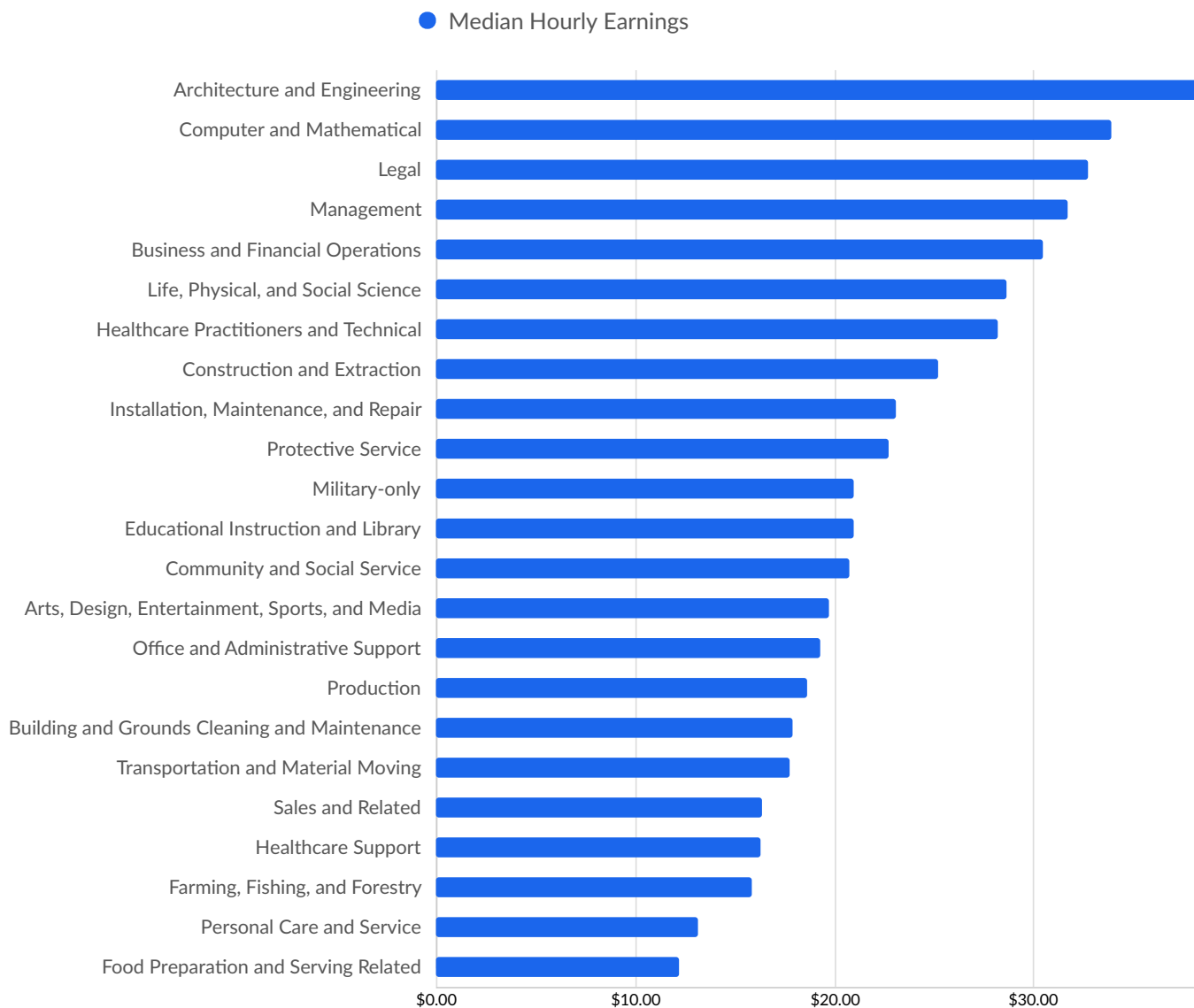
Top Growing Occupations



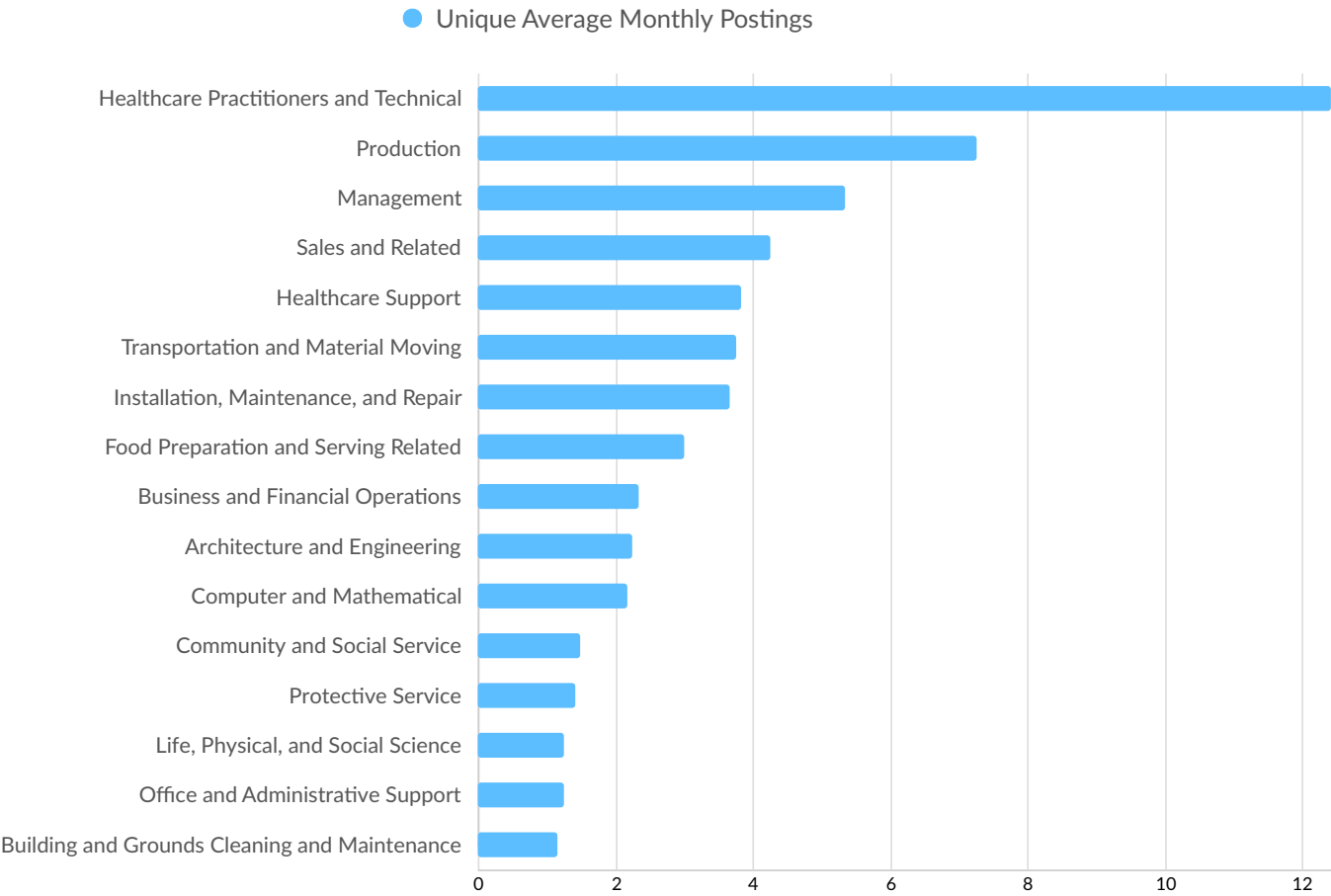
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



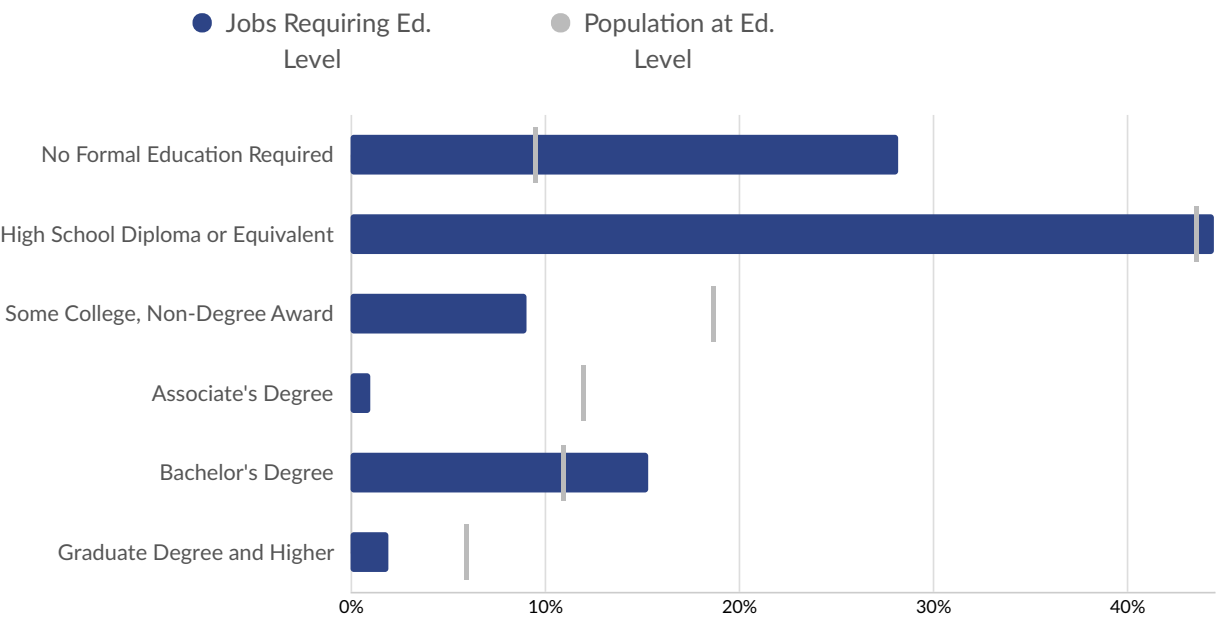
