FAQs

What: The Pike School’s first-ever drive-in movie event, featuring “Night at the Museum”. Click [here](#) for the commonsense media movie review.

When and Where: Thursday, May 27, 2021 at the Topsfield Fairgrounds. Doors open at 5:30 p.m., movie begins shortly after sunset. Address is 207 Boston Street, Topsfield. Please [click here](#) for directions.

Who: This drive-in movie is free for current and newly admitted Pike School families, and is sponsored by the Family School Partnership! RSVPs are required, please [click here](#).

Arrival time: Please arrive as early as possible to secure the best parking space. The venue encourages families to come early and enjoy dinner time in or around your car to avoid traffic in the 30 minutes prior to showtime. Once the movie begins, the venue is unable to guarantee admittance.

Parking: Upon arrival at the main entrance, signage and parking attendants will direct you to your parking space. Cars will be parked 6-8 feet apart and arranged in such a way that allows you to leave anytime. If you would like to park next to a specific car, please plan to arrive together. The venue suggests meeting somewhere else and driving in together. Parking attendants are not able to save parking spaces.

Tailgating: Families may sit in or outside of their vehicles before and after the movie. There will be space directly in front of each vehicle for chairs, etc. Cars may also choose to back in, in order to tailgate.

Health and Wellness: Masks are required while you are away from your vehicle, for example at the concession stand or restroom. The venue asks that families remember social distancing requirements while in line. Masks are not required while tailgating or sitting in front of your vehicle. For purposes of health and wellness, the FSP asks that families *do not* carpool and only immediate household members ride in the same car.

Food and Drink: The venue has a no-outside food policy. Concessions are available directly to the right and rear of the screen in a large white tent. [Click here](#) for the concession menu. Families with dietary restrictions are permitted to bring their own food. The venue has a no-alcohol policy, however juice boxes and similar drinks are permitted. Facilities: There are portable restrooms near the concession stands, as well as permanent restrooms within walking distance (the length of a football field away).

Media: Prior to the start of the movie, we will be playing Pike School videos, trivia games, and a family-friendly music playlist. Audio for the movie will be accessible through your car radio. Radios will also be available for those who aren't able to access radio in their vehicles. Please inquire at the concession stand.
