## Face Coverings



A face covering is a non-medical mask such as a cloth mask or bandanna. Face Coverings may be used as one of the controls to reduce the risk of transmission of COVID-19.

## **How to Use a Face Covering**

When wearing a face covering:

- Wash your hands immediately before putting it on and immediately after taking it off.
- Make sure it fits well around your nose and mouth.
- Avoid touching, moving, or adjusting it as much as possible.
- Do not share it with others.
- · Change it when it gets damp or soiled.

## **How to Clean a Face Covering**

- Put it directly into the washing machine or a bag that can be emptied into the washing machine;
- Wash with other items using a hot cycle with laundry detergent (no special soaps are needed); and
- Dry thoroughly.

All face coverings that cannot be cleaned should be thrown out and replaced as soon as they get damp, soiled or crumpled.



Make sure to wash your hands often and especially after touching your face covering.
