Mission Mastermind Impact Report, an update on how, thanks to your partnership, we are helping Ukrainians get back on their feet to rebuild their lives as well as their community.

We put your donations into the hands of our trusted Ukrainian nonprofit partners:
Allied Extract, Bird of Light Ukraine, Artesans ResQ, and The Mozart Group.

With our partners, we are delivering humanitarian aid to those in need and are saving lives by extracting the most vulnerable from the front lines.

Allied Extract is a trusted partner that identifies global needs, develops relief programs, and executes humanitarian aid and extractions in conflict zones.

Updates Include:

- (+) Tracking a cargo container of medical supplies gathered in the U.S. and preparing for its delivery throughout Ukraine
- (+) Securing a large donation of vests from a police department and six large advanced medical packs that were designed to serve as the complete medical kits for large seafaring vessels' crews (these items and more will be taken on the Krohn Breakthrough Foundation team's next mission)
- (+) Laying the foundation for three Wartime Reconstruction Community Centers (WRCC), which include Starlink units for Wi-Fi, generators for electricity, chargers for cell phones, stoves for heat, supplies for hot tea and soup, and they are staffed with trusted teams with a dedicated 4WD vehicle
- (+) Actively procuring aid for the April 2023 mission
- (+) Continuing to support our other partners in Ukraine

Oleh, an Allied Extract volunteer in Ukraine, is currently serving as an interpreter for an emergency medical training course. He is the "can-do" guy in Ukraine who finds a way to accomplish any task or resolve any need.

Oleh is from a village in Ukraine called Sosnivka. He was a college athlete and had gone to a university in Poland before the Russian invasion of Ukraine. Initially, Oleh began volunteering by handing out goods to refugees as they entered Poland and by shuttling humanitarian aid to the border. He did not enter Ukraine, because as a young Ukrainian male, he would not have been permitted to leave. Ultimately, Oleh decided to go back to Ukraine and help his people and his country. That is how the orphanage and shelter program began.

From feeding thousands of refugees to providing strategic support to single families, Bird of Light operates in Ukraine to respond to the needs of its people, be it heat, clothing, or food.



Updates Include:

- ⊕ Building and delivering life-sustaining stoves. The Krohn Breakthrough Foundation is working with Allied Extract and Bird of Light Ukraine to build 480 wood stoves made of steel and deliver them to front-line civilians, refugee centers, and internally displaced citizens to provide life-sustaining heat.

- ⊕ So far this month, Bird of Light has helped 155 internally displaced persons who received household essentials such as freezers, microwaves, cooking equipment, and more. These items have significantly improved their quality of life.

Bird of Light is completing the Gifts of Light program and continues to deliver and install equipment (alongside Allied Extract) that will keep the water running, provide heat, and allow preparation of meals without long wait times in their shelter.

Evacuation of 10-Year-Old Boy

We were called by the national burn center for an evacuation. The 10-year-old boy suffered after an accident of a 70% surface burn (65% 3rd degree). It was not possible to do what was necessary in Ukraine, so an evacuation was requested. These patients are the most difficult to transfer, as the infection risk is very high. We created a specialized burn bed and an isolated environment and transported this boy in two steps (from Kyiv to Lviv, and then from Lviv to Poland).

The boy was one of the toughest we have ever seen. He always had a smile on his face and was very thankful for the transport. He is now in a burn center of a hospital

The Mozart Group is a team of Tier One Special Operations Veterans, to evacuate front-line civilians in Ukraine and train medical units, often amid heavy fire.

Images from their “Aid in, People Out” program are below:

Updates Include:

- ⊕ Artesans ResQ is stocking up the ambulance and preparing for what is expected to be a January riddled with many more casualties than prior months
- ⊕ They have Evacuated 110 critical patients (in the prior 180 days)




