Structure of the 2021-2022 Student Council

- 3 representatives at large from each grade
 - Must be elected by their grade
- No class presidents/ vice presidents
- Student Council President, Vice President, and Secretary are the 3 senior grade representatives
- 12 members, 3 of which are the leaders (seniors)
- The advisors have the ability to appoint one qualified student per grade if necessary

Requirements for Joining the Council:

- No honor offenses
- Minimum of a 3.0 GPA
- Not already a leader in another council (Service/Honor)
 - Can be a member, but can not have a leadership role in both

Responsibilities of the Council as a Whole:

- Organize and plan homecoming week and homecoming dance
 - Theme Days
 - Floats
 - Skits
 - Banners
- Service events
- Halloween costume contest
- Give outside of school opportunities for students to meet (movie night, bingo...)
- Coordinate activities for Field Day
- Make an active effort to improve the culture of the school by attending school-sponsored events and encouraging others to do so

Duties for Each Role:

- Student Council President
 - Have initiatives approved by US Administration
 - Lead and call weekly meetings
 - Call supplementary meetings if needed

- Lead assembly every Monday
- Speak at school events when asked
- Take initiative in planning out of school events for students
- Take on the most responsibility for the events detailed in “Responsibilities of the Council as a Whole”
- Schedule one supplementary meeting a week with the leaders
- Student Council Vice President
 - Create meeting agendas
 - Second in command to Student Council President
 - Aid Student Council President in delegating responsibilities, making decisions for the council, and planning all events
 - Lead service aspects and events
- Secretary
 - Take attendance at each meeting
 - Take minutes during the meeting
 - Does email corresponding

Individual Responsibilities as a Member of the Student Council:

- Mandatory attendance to every meeting
 - Three unexcused absences will result in removal from the council
- Contribution of ideas and opinions
- Attendance at student council sponsored events
- Willingness to help with planning and setting up events
- You may be removed by the advisors if you fail to uphold your position’s responsibility
