### **COVID-19 Spectator Protocol**

In an effort to compete in the 2020-2021 basketball season, Robert Toombs has implemented the following protocols for attendance at all indoor Winter Events. We will take all precautions necessary to ensure the safety of our athletes and spectators. We ask that you help us in our efforts to have a safe and completed season.

- 1. Masks are mandated while inside the Basketball Arena
- 2. Adhere to Signage Recommending to Practice Social Distancing when Possible.
- 3. Hand Sanitizing Stations will be Provided Throughout Facility
- 4. Home Cheerleaders will have a Designated Section Behind the Home Basketball Bench. Visiting Cheerleaders will have a Designated Section on the Visiting Bleacher side.
- 5. Robert Toombs Band will be Located on the Stage. Noone will be allowed to Enter the Stage Area.
- Pre-purchased Tickets are Strongly Encouraged to allow for an Estimation on that Night's Capacity
- 7. The First Row of Seating Behind Each Team's Bench will be Restricted from Fan Seating.
- 8. GISA Passes and RTCA Booster Passes will be accepted.

## **COVID-19 Visiting Team Protocol**

In an effort to compete in the 2020-2021 basketball season, Robert Toombs has implemented the following protocols for attendance at all indoor Winter games. We will take all precautions necessary to ensure the safety of our athletes and spectators. We ask that you help us in our efforts to have a safe and completed season.

- 1. Team Members, Coaches & Managers are only individuals permitted in the Locker Room Space.
- 2. Team Members & Coaches on the Bench will be Mandated to Wear a Mask
- 3. Water coolers will be provided for each team. Cups, water bottles or other watering devices will be the responsibility of the visiting team to provide.
- All GISA Mandates & Protocols will be Followed.

### **BASKETBALL**

- 1. Hand sanitizer is required to be made available at the scorer's table for players, officials, substitutions, and game personnel.
- 2. GISA will require benches to be sanitized between games if you are hosting multiple games in one day.
- 3. Jump ball will be eliminated. Ball will be awarded to the visiting team to start the game with the first alternating possession for throw-in. To start an overtime period, use a coin toss to determine which team is awarded the ball.
- 4. Coaches must wear a mask when approaching officials.
- 5. Each school shall determine the number of fans they will allow at an event. Host schools <u>must</u> allow the same amount of spectators for both home and away teams. The number of spectators allowed MUST be communicated with your opponent in advance. Please communicate these

protocols **early and often** with your opponents so the information can be passed to fans.

#### WRESTLING

- 1. GISA will require wrestlers to wear masks during weigh-ins.
- 2. GISA will require wrestlers to sanitize before and after each match.
- 3. A hand sanitizing station must be made available for wrestlers.
- 4. After the winner of a match is announced, refrain from approaching the opposing coach.
- 5. Masks must be worn by coaches if approaching the official at the scorer's table. Wrestlers will not sign the score sheet, but coaches will sign the score sheet. When coaches sign the score sheet, they must be masked and bring their own pen.
- 6. During State Championship event: No water will be provided. Each school must provide its own water bottles (sharing of these items is prohibited).
- 7. Sharing towels is prohibited.
- 8. No hospitality room will be provided.
