**Minimum Requirements to Apply:**

- Applicant must be a rising junior or senior
- Applicant must have a minimum unweighted GPA of 3.0 in core curriculum classes (English, Science, Math, Social Science, Foreign Language)
- Official SAT or ACT scores are required:
  - SAT: a minimum of 970 must be achieved with exempting scores in the Critical Reading and Math sections, with minimum scores of 500 on either the Critical Reading or Math
  - ACT: a minimum of 20 on the Composite section with exempting scores in the English and Math sections a minimum score of 21 on either English or Math

**Cost:** Tuition for this program is funded by State revenues. Books will be loaned to students by the college. Only courses approved by the Georgia Student Finance Commission to be Dual Enrollment approved college courses will be covered by State revenues.

Rising juniors are permitted to enroll in one course per semester. Rising seniors are permitted to enroll in a maximum of two courses per semester.

**By signing this application, you acknowledge that you are aware of the following:**

- Correspondence regarding the course you are enrolled in will be directly through the College of Coastal Georgia.
- You must abide by the policies and procedures the College of Coastal Georgia outlines for visiting and Dual Enrollment students.
- You may not substitute a required Frederica Academy class or credit or a College of Coastal Georgia class.
- Frederica Academy is not responsible for your progress in the course in which you enroll.
- Frederica Academy will obtain a copy of your College of Coastal Georgia transcript, to ensure courses and grades are reported to the colleges to which you apply.
- Frederica Academy will send an official high school transcript to the College of Coastal Georgia, once you have submitted a formal application to the College.
- **Once this application is submitted, you will be required to complete an official application to the College of Coastal Georgia at [www.GAFutures.org](http://www.GAFutures.org). An appointment can be made with Mrs. Nevins to complete the application.**

- You must submit your standardized test scores to the College of Coastal Georgia. This can be done by logging into your College Board and/or ACT account.
- The grade received in the course in which you enroll in will count towards your cumulative high school and college GPA. Courses will be weighted 5 points for numeric average and 0.5 for GPA on Frederica Academy's transcript.
- Course enrollment is subject to change based on availability and the student's Frederica Academy schedule.
