**BASKETBALL HOME GAME GUIDELINES**

We are excited about the opportunity for our Student-Athletes to participate in Winter Sports. We have adopted the following policies and guidelines in regards to athletic competition to help mitigate the spread of COVID 19.

**SPECTATORS**

We will be limiting the number of spectators to 2 per athlete and coach, names must be submitted 24 hours prior to the game and will be kept at the gate. No more than 2 guests per athlete or coach is allowed to enter and must be pre registered (this includes children and dependents).

We will need a roster of all the basketball teams to include coaches, managers, bookkeepers and filmers to be emailed 24 hours prior to the game to the Athletic Director.

The cost of admission will be \$8.00 cash.

The Gate will open to spectators 15 minutes prior to the start of the game.

The Gate will be located at the end of the gym closest to the road.

The gym will be emptied at the conclusion of each game.

All spectators must wear a mask or face coverings while you are on campus or attending an athletic competition. No one will be admitted to any contest without a mask or face covering, and it must be worn properly (fully covering the mouth and nose) the entire time.

All spectators must have temperature taken prior to entrance into the gym and temperature must be below 99.8 and be COVID screened.

Concessions will not be open.

The seating area for visiting spectators will be clearly marked.

No spectator from the visitor or home team will be allowed to enter the competition area at any point before, during or at the conclusion of the competition.

We ask that the visiting team and spectators exit the stadium in a timely manner at the conclusion of the game.

Coaches, statistician, bookkeeper and managers and clock keeper must wear masks.

We will follow all GISA game protocol mandates.

## **VISITING TEAM**

Prior to boarding the team transportation, each individual student-athlete and coach should be verbally screened and temperature checked with appropriate action taken as necessary. Each temperature should be taken prior to departure and upon arrival.

The following questions should be answered in screening;

Have you had a fever?

Have you had a cough?

Have you had a sore throat?

Have you had shortness of breath?

Have you experienced a recent loss of taste or smell?

Have you come in close contact or cared for someone with Covi-19 or flu-like symptoms?

The temperature of all Coaches and Players will be checked prior to entry in the gym.

Coaches should wear mask/face coverings in the field.

The doors to the locker room will be open to your team 45 minutes prior to the start of the game.

Teams will not shake hands prior, during or after the game.

Please bring your own balls.

Athletes will need to bring their own water bottles.

Bring your own coolers with ice we will supply the water.

We ask that the visiting team and spectators exit the field in a timely manner at the conclusion of the game

## **Possible Exposure**

Both schools agree to notify the other school if they receive information indicating that a student, coach, or spectator was CoVID-19 positive while in attendance at the event, providing all relevant and available information for the purpose of each school being able to do contact tracing.

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
