

Dear Region 2-AAA Schools,

I hope this letter finds everyone well. Bulloch Academy has the honor of hosting the Region 2-AAA Basketball Tournament on February 8th, 10th, and 11th. Our priority is to provide the best possible environment for our players, coaches, officials, and spectators. As we continue with these unprecedented times, we will still have some procedures in place to ensure the safety of those in attendance. The Bulloch Academy Health and Safety Committee and the Department of Public Health has recommended that all spectators wear face masks. This is the same requirement that we had during our regular season contest.

This year's tournament will continue with many of the normal procedures which most of us are accustomed to. Tickets for all games of the region tournament will be purchased with cash only at the main entrance of our Legacy Gymnasium. GISA passes will be honored and those pass holders will be allowed to bring one more person in attendance with their pass. To maximize the parking on campus, all teams are required to park down at the football field/ track area closest to the visitors bleachers. All players, coaches, cheerleaders, trainers, and pass holders will enter the side of the Legacy Gymnasium located closest to the football field ticket booth. From this point they will be escorted to their respective locker rooms for that evening's contest. The warm up time between games will be fifteen minutes, also halftime warm ups for each team will be held in the Arthur Howard Arena located directly beside the game gym. Each team should bring warm up balls for the halftime and pregame warm ups. The region will provide game balls. Also, the region will provide an official bookkeeper, and your teams can still have your regular bookkeepers sit at the scorers table to keep their individual books. All games will be live streamed on NFHS and on Facebook Live with game commentary.

Bulloch Academy is excited to be hosting this year's region basketball tournament. We are anticipating great games and atmospheres for all our teams. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation. We look forward to seeing you at the games!

2022 Region 2-AAA Basketball Tournament @ Bulloch Academy

Please take note of the information listed below to ensure a quality region basketball tournament. Administrators, Athletic Directors, and Coaches make sure to pass this information along to whomever it pertains to.

Admission: Admission to each game will be \$12 for adults and \$8 for students. Please remind your fans and students of price increases for the region tournament. The GISA pass will be accepted at the Pass Gate located at the gym door entrance near the football field ticket booth.

Live Stream: Bulloch Academy will provide two live stream options for viewers. The first is with the use of the NFHS camera and the second broadcast will be on Facebook Live with live play-by-play and color commentary feed of each game. Radio broadcasters will have a table set up on the side of the gymnasiums for their broadcast.

Parking: Buses will be parked at the first entrance on Westside Road located beside the football field and track area. Teams need to walk the track to the football bleachers on their way to the player gate.

Player Gate: The player gate will be located at the side of the gym near the football field ticket booth. All coaches, players, trainers, managers, filmmakers, and cheerleaders must enter through this gate each day.

Rosters: Please email all rosters for your basketball teams to awoodard@bullochacademy.com by Tuesday, February 8th by noon.

Cheerleaders: Cheerleaders are encouraged to attend all games played during the tournament and will be placed in the bleachers on the far side of the gymnasium located closest to the locker rooms.

Locker Rooms: Each school will be assigned a locker room each night, and will be escorted to their locker rooms upon arrival to campus.

Balls: Each school should bring their own balls for pregame and halftime warm ups. The region has purchased balls and nets for competition.

Uniform Color: The higher seed will be designated as the home team, use the home bench, and wear white uniforms.

Officials: Officials assigned for each game will be from the Southern Eagle Basketball Officials Association.

Clock & Book: Bulloch Academy will provide a clock operator and official scorer for each game. This individual will keep the official book for the tournament. Each school may have one book person behind the scoring table.

Hospitality Suite: A hospitality suite will be provided at the Cornerstone Building each evening for coaches, athletic directors, and school administrators. The Cornerstone Building is directly in front of the Legacy Gymnasium.

Concessions: A concession stand will be open every day during the tournament game. It will serve drinks, chips, popcorn, hamburgers, hotdogs, candy, etc for all fans in attendance.

Other Tournament Notes:

- Teams are asked to arrive at the player gate no earlier than one hour before the scheduled start time of their game.
- Teams will be given a twenty minute warm during halftime of the game prior to theirs in the Arthur Howard Arena.
- A fifteen minute warm-up period prior to the start of each game. (Including the 1st game of the day)
- The use of mechanical noisemakers (pep bands, bugles, drums, whistles, horns, etc) shall NOT be permitted. No large signs are permitted (Region 2-AAA by-laws).
- On site security will be provided by the Bulloch County Sheriff's Department.
- At the conclusion of the championship games trophies will be presented to the Region Runner Up and Region Champion. After the trophy presentation the championship teams will cut down the nets.
