

First semester exams are scheduled for December 13-15th.

On exam days, students should arrive at school no earlier than 8:45. Exams begin promptly at 9:00 and end at 11:00. However, students can be dismissed for the day at 10:30 if they are finished with their exam. If your child has an accommodation plan that allows extra testing time, you should pick up your child after that period (please contact Ms. Toomey for that time).

Exam Days:

Monday, December 13th is the Science Exam day. This is a paper exam. Students should bring 2 sharpened pencils, a water bottle, and a book (to read in case they complete their exam early). Students should report to the assigned room specified on the posted class rosters. Class rosters will be posted the morning of the exam in both Middle School hallways.

Tuesday, December 14th is the Math Exam day. This is a paper exam. Students should bring 2 sharpened pencils, a calculator (grades 5th & 6th will have one provided), a water bottle, and a book (to read in case they complete their exam early). Students should report to the assigned room specified on the posted class rosters. Class rosters will be posted the morning of the exam in both Middle School hallways.

Wednesday, December 15th is the Language Exam day. Students in **5th grade ONLY** will **NOT** take a language exam and will **NOT** be required to come to school for testing. Students **EXEMPT** from taking a foreign language are also **NOT** required to come to school for testing. This is a paper exam. Students in 6th, 7th, and 8th should bring 2 sharpened pencils, a water bottle, and a book (to read in case they complete their exam early). Students should report to the assigned room specified on the posted class rosters. Class rosters will be posted the morning of the exam in both Middle School hallways.

The exams for English and History classes are projects that will be completed during class over the next two weeks. If you would like to learn more about the projects, the student instructions can be found in Google Classroom.

Exam days are dress-down days; no uniforms are required.
