Babysitting 101

Rising 6th - 12th graders

Week 1: June 4th - June 7th from 9:00am-12:00pm

Tuition: \$100

Learn the skills to become a great babysitter! Combining real life practice sessions and on-line modules, you will earn a Red Cross Babysitting Certificate and American Heart Association CPR Certificate.
