CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

FREDERICA ACADEMY FINE ARTS HALL OF FAME

The purpose of the Frederica Academy Fine Arts Hall of Fame is to honor and recognize alumni and educators who have been outstanding in realm of the arts professions and arts education. The award can also be given to other alumni or educators who have given meritorious service to the Fine Arts program at Frederica Academy.

OFFICERS AND MEMBERS OF SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Hall of Fame Committee will consist of nine (9) members. The members will consist of the following:

- Current Director of Development and Alumni Relations
- Current Fine Arts Director, or their appointed representative
- Current Frederica Academy Fine Arts Teachers
- At-Large Community representatives who are appointed by majority selection from the set committee members (Veteran Faculty Members, Board of Visitors, etc.)

The purpose of the committee is to nominate and elect Fine Arts Hall of Fame honorees, and select inductees. For the Fine Arts Hall of Fame Committee to conduct official business, a quorum of five (5) members is necessary. All committee members (9) will have full voting privileges concerning committee action.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE FREDERICA ACADEMY FINE ARTS HALL OF FAME

A person can qualify for the Hall of Fame by falling into one of two categories:

- Alumni Honoree
- Educator Honoree

1. Alumni Honoree

Those who participated in Frederica Academy in any of the school's Fine Arts Programs, having earned meritorious commendation from their fine arts teachers for at least 2 years. In the classroom, these students distinguished themselves above their peers in the arts. In addition to their in-school arts participation, the student may have received honors or

recognition at a local, regional or State level from an agency outside of the school. The student artist must have graduated from Frederica Academy and have been out of school for more than five (5) years.

A Frederica Academy graduate who participated in Frederica Academy Upper School Arts programs and participated or focused in collegiate arts, or has attained a profession in the arts. This person must have been out of school for a minimum of five (5) years.

2. Distinguished Educator Honoree

Those who have given meritorious service, or have been a loyal friend to the Fine Arts program. A Frederica Academy Fine Arts educator, which has attained record status or state recognition and been five (5) years removed from the school.

SELECTION PROCESS AND RECOGNITION

- Names for nomination can be submitted by anyone or by the committee by submitting a Nomination Form.
- The person nominated must be seconded by someone on the committee. If a person is on the ballot and has not received more than 2 votes, they will be removed from the list. That person may be re-nominated in a future year.
- In the event that a committee member is being considered as a candidate for the Fine Arts Hall of Fame, they are not allowed to vote when their name comes up and they must receive a minimum of 75% of the vote.
- The Selection Committee will present the final nominees to the Leadership and Board.
