**Mrs. Rentz:** Good morning, Mary Ford. Tell our readers about your Instagram account.

**Mary Ford:** It's called [@seemaryread](#). For each post, I include a picture of me reading the book, a review, a really good quote for the book, and then a picture of me as a baby reading a baby book.

**Mrs. Rentz:** Where did you get the idea to start a book review blog on Instagram?

**Mary Ford:** Well, my friend's parents are always asking about good books that I've read and so my mom said why don't you start a blog about all of the books that you've read. So it's an easy way to share with everyone great books to read.

**Mrs. Rentz:** What is your favorite book you have reviewed?

**Mary Ford:** I have a couple. The first one is [Serafina and the Black Cloak](#) by Robert Beatty, and the second one is *The Westing Game* by Ellen Raskin. These are both mysteries. I really like mysteries.

**Mrs. Rentz:** What is the earliest memory you have of reading?

**Mary Ford:** When I was two, I used to read my dad's newspapers.

**Mrs. Rentz:** On your blog, do you have any followers that surprised you?

**Mary Ford:** Yes, actually I have a lot of followers who are authors and publishers of the books that I have reviewed. And, an author recently sent me a book to read and review!

**Mrs. Rentz:** What is the next book you plan to review?

**Mary Ford:** The next post will feature *Glow* which is about the radium girls. But the next book I plan to review is *The Key to Extraordinary* by Natalie Floyd. It's about a girl whose mother dies and her father moves away and now she lives next to a cemetery. Weird things have been happening in the cemetery so it's up to her to find out what is happening and who has been causing these problems.

**Mrs. Rentz:** Where is your favorite place to read and why?

**Mary Ford:** Anywhere! But my favorite is either here at school or at my house on the couch. When I'm reading at my house I feel very close to my family and it makes me feel happy to just relax. When I read here at Frederica, I really like it because I feel like my friends are all around me, and it just feels comfortable. And if I laugh at a book, I get to tell my friends what happened.

**Mrs. Rentz:** Where is the strangest place you've read a book?

**Mary Ford:** One time we were in Chicago and I brought my book along with me and there was a huge wait to use the bathroom, so I just read my book while I waited in line!
