



YOUTH LEADERSHIP GLYNN PROGRAM

Dear Students & Parents,

The Youth Leadership Glynn program is in its 23rd year of sponsorship by the Brunswick-Golden Isles Chamber of Commerce. This program is designed to prepare and educate our emerging young leaders on community issues while furthering their knowledge of Brunswick and Glynn County.

The program is offered to select high school students with strong leadership potential and is designed to:

- Present in-depth programs that will acquaint students with community needs and resources and provide interaction with community leaders and decision makers.
- Develop an understanding of leadership qualities, team building skills and community service.
- Provide opportunities for students to develop a level of mutual respect and trust.

Program Requirements:

- **Student must be a high school sophomore or junior.**
- Student must have reliable transportation to and from scheduled activities.
- Student must be able to attend one half-day per month with a schedule that will be given out at orientation.
- Student is only allowed to miss only TWO sessions during the year and may not leave sessions early; in realizing that some students have extremely active after-school schedules, college courses, etc. please keep this in mind when discussing the program with your child. *Coaches should be made aware of this policy as well and agree to the program requirements.*

The application period opens Monday, April 18th and closes Monday, May 2nd.

Applications should be turned into your school's guidance counselor, the organization's administrator or the person who informed you of the program. The final decision about who will participate in the program will be decided by a committee formed by the Chamber Foundation Board of Directors. Once the application period closes, each student will be called in for a group interview during the last two weeks of April. Students will be notified if they have been selected to participate in Youth Leadership Glynn Class of 2021-2022. Once the students have been notified, more information on the program will be sent to the students and parents. The program will begin in the fall once school has resumed.

Cost to participate for the year is \$35 per student. You may pay via cash, credit card or check.
