Mission Statement

The purpose of the Junior Board is to develop and promote civic leadership and responsibility for the individuals selected and to enrich their knowledge of the community, its history and business environment through association with United Community Bank, its officers and board of directors.

Duties

Criteria for Serving on Junior Board

Students serving on the Junior Board of UCBI will be expected to meet the following set of criteria: Student must be a rising Junior or Senior, 3.0 overall GPA, 95% attendance rate, no major discipline infractions (any major discipline infraction during the year of your participation can be grounds for dismissal from the board). To be considered, you must submit an application along with at least one teacher recommendation.

Meetings

- You WILL BE expected to attend monthly board meetings September through May. **Meetings will be held the 2nd Wednesday of every month beginning promptly with breakfast at 7:15 a.m. and the meeting from 7:30 - 8:30 a.m.**
- You will also be expected to wear United Community Bank shirts on board meeting days as well as other designated days for special events, activities, etc... The shirts will be provided to you free of charge.
- You will be expected to participate in community projects. **You MUST be able to devote the time (including after school & some weekends) to help determine, develop and implement a plan to achieve goals for the project.**

Field Trip

United Community Bank will arrange a special field trip for the Junior Board of Directors. Previous locations for the field trip include the Federal Reserve Bank in Jacksonville and the Ft. Stewart army base.
