A MESSAGE FROM OUR CHURCH COUNCIL PRESIDENT:

Grace, mercy, and peace to you in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ

As we head into the summer months, and have now endured several months in our Pastoral vacancy, I know that there are still so many unanswered questions and many of you have grown weary of the uncertainty of what the future holds for Messiah Evangelical Lutheran Church. I too have had so many questions and have spent a lot of time in prayer over what our role is as a congregation in this time. It's very funny how God sends us answers sometimes. When I was shopping recently, I was thirsty, so I picked up a Coke. I don't know how many of you drink Coke (it's really not the best thing for any of us), but their summer campaign involves their "Share a Coke with..." theme. Of all of the Coke bottles that I could have picked up, I grabbed Isaiah. I wasn't sure why, but then I figured I'd take a look at Isaiah and see what he had to say to me. On top of a LOT of fantastic prophecy, there was one section that spoke to me, and I'm hoping that it speaks to you as well:

Isaiah 40: 28-31

Do you not know?
Have you not heard?
The LORD is the everlasting God,
the Creator of the ends of the earth.
He will not grow tired or weary,
and his understanding no one can fathom.

- ²⁹ He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.
- ³⁰ Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall;
- 31 but those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength.

They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.

I hope that you too, can find the strength in the words of Isaiah that I found. While I can't claim to know the answers, I know that God is our divine master and that he knows what the future holds for all of us. I encourage you to join me in prayer, for whenever two or more of us gather, God will be with us.
