## A MESSAGE FROM OUR CHURCH COUNCIL PRESIDENT:

Dear Brothers and Sisters of Messiah,

***Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.***

As we get into the heart of our new year and approach the Lenten season, I've been thinking about both resolutions and Lenten goals. This year, I'd like to approach my Lenten season by diving deeper into my Bible and also leaning more into what Martin Luther teaches us about it.

As many of you know, I teach the Confirmands of Messiah. At this time, we finished learning about the Apostles Creed and how Martin Luther explained each part of it. We will be learning about the Lord's Prayer in February. I know that all of you are familiar with the Lord's Prayer and can probably say it without thinking about it, but I'm inviting you to actually think about it. Martin Luther teaches us the meanings of things that we assume that we understand, but do we actually? Think about the most basic petition in this prayer:

***Give us this day our daily bread.***

***What does this mean?*** God certainly gives daily bread to everyone without our prayers, even to all evil people, but we pray in this petition that God would lead us to realize this and to receive our daily bread with thanksgiving.

***What is meant by daily bread?*** Daily bread includes everything that has to do with the support and needs of the body, such as food, drink, clothing, shoes, house, home, land, animals, money, goods, a devout husband or wife, devout children, devout workers, devout and faithful rulers, good government, good weather, peace, health, self-control, good reputation, good friends, faithful neighbors, and the like.

I was going to summarize, but Martin Luther explains things so much better than I do. Think about how profound the term "Daily bread" is. It's EVERYTHING that we need to meet our daily needs. Now let's think about this; all these things belong to God and he bestows them upon us because he loves us. How much do we love him? If he gives us all of this out of love, how much are we willing to give to him in faith and love for all that he does for us?

***How can we share the gifts God has given us?*** Going into Lent, I would invite you to look deeper into yourself and consider what blessings and gifts God has given you. What are you able to give to him?

Fill out a "***Times, Talents, and Treasures form***". Consider ways that you could take part in something, rather than giving something up. Or even deeper still, share your time. Share your talents. Even still, share your treasures.

Fill out an "***Offering Pledge Card***". If you've never considered tithing before, think about what that would look like for you. Pray over it and consider how you can return some of what God has given you to help sharing in his Word and the life of the church.

Come to midweek Lenten devotions. Come to services. Listen to God's word and take this season, so often associated with giving up and consider it a season of giving ourselves to God.

We look forward to seeing more of you more often.




