PASTOR NIEMEIER'S NOTE:

Dear Brothers and Sisters at Messiah,

On Palm Sunday, I had the privilege of admitting seven of our young people to the Lord's Table for the first time. It's always an exciting event for me, because it means that these young folks are more fully able to partake in the life of the church and are able to receive God's gifts to them in the Sacrament of the Altar. No more waiting for them–they get to receive the Body and Blood of Jesus given and shed for them for the forgiveness of their sins.

Part of the preparation for admitting children to the Lord's Table involves some question-and-answer time with the pastor to make sure that they understand what it is they are partaking of. We do this because Paul warns us in 1 Corinthians 11 against receiving the Sacrament while not discerning that it is Christ's Body and Blood in, with, and under the bread and wine. He says that not understanding that Christ is truly present in the Sacrament can lead to eating and drinking judgment upon oneself. Suffice it to say, it's important to understand this. If the Sacrament of the Altar is the medicine of immortality, then the proper understanding of what it is and what it's for is important to proper "dosage" and "use." But when we know that the Sacrament is Christ's Body and Blood, oh what an incomparable gift we receive: Christ's Body and Blood given and shed for us for the forgiveness of sins!

Anyway, one of the children I examined was so thrilled when I told her she was ready to receive the Sacrament that she physically could not contain her excitement. She ran about the room, jumped up and down—it was like Christmas morning for her, so happy was she to be able to receive Christ for the strengthening of her body and soul. Her joy models the sort of joy we ought to have every time we commune.

For every time we come to the altar, we are invited to have a foretaste of the feast to come, the feast that will be forever inaugurated when Christ returns in glory. We taste heaven, we eat the bread of angels. We partake of one of the greatest mysteries of the faith, and Christ Himself is our food. Is that not incredible? Is that not something we should be jumping for joy to receive?

Lutherans jumping for joy is of course an odd image–we've got a reputation for being reserved! But regardless, brothers and sisters, we ought to be joyous in our hearts and not more than a bit awed at the miracle we witness every week. I hope that we can all recapture that childlike awe and exuberance over coming to the Table. I look forward to seeing you at Sunday's feast.


