Through their oversight, all aspects of worship, education, ministry, and church life are handled responsibly.

Finance Board - handles the finances of the church

Board of Evangelism - handles outreach to the community

Board of Stewardship - encourages members for service to the congregation

Board of Youth - plan youth events

Altar Guild - handles the setup of the altar for communion, along with providing flowers and special holiday memorials

LWML - put together the different kits (personal care, school and baby) to go to those in need through Lutheran World Relief

Service Helpers - lectors, acolytes, communion assistants, ushers, live stream, power point, musicians, etc.
