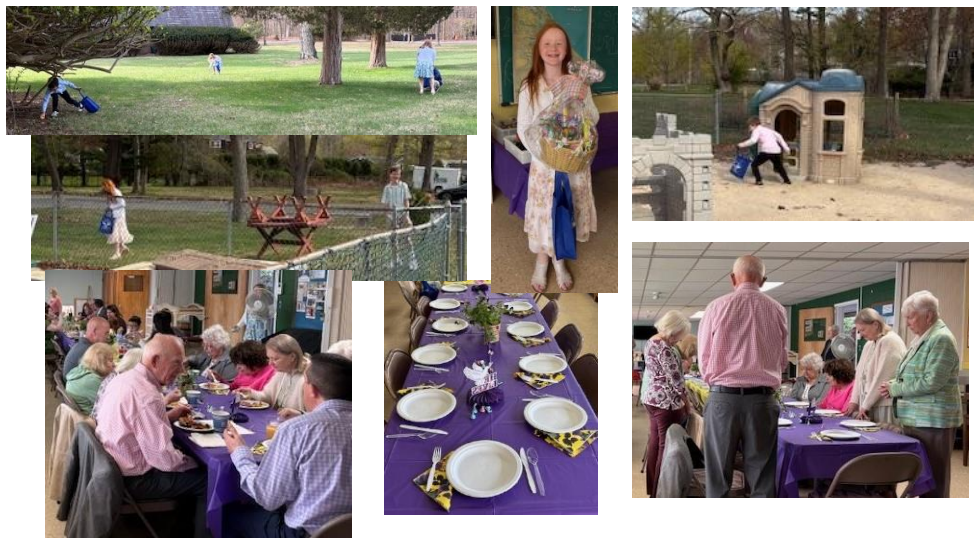

Come with us to the True North this year!

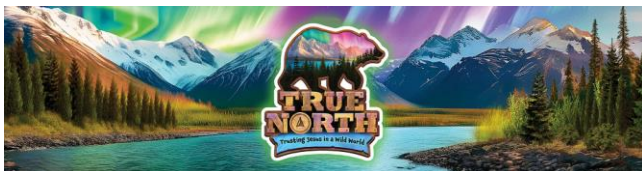
VBS will be held from August 25-29th.
