Greetings and Blessings to everyone in our Messiah Family,

Grace, mercy, and peace to you in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

A friend recently sent me the following scripture:

Exodus 14:14: "The Lord will fight for you; you need only to be still".

This scripture is so relevant as we head into the holidays when things are so busy. It's even more relevant for us as a congregation when things are starting to get frustrating. With the lack of pastoral coverage, we've been scrambling to put together lay leadership, find sermons, and just run the church in general. At times like this, it seems so disheartening and it's so easy to just give up and to not trust in the process.

This verse speaks so clearly to us, but the most important thing for us to understand about it, is how chaotic the situation was when it was given. This verse appears at an incredibly critical time in Bible history. It is a part of the story where the Israelites are trapped between the Red Sea and the pursuing Egyptian army. They are reminded to just be still and trust in God.

While it is incredibly hard to trust in God when things are so uncertain, we can remember that God is always faithful to us if we just trust in Him. He parted the Red Sea and delivered the Israelites. He will deliver us just as surely if we just have faith and let Him do his work.


