

## TUESDAY, AUGUST 6<sup>TH</sup> IS A SPECIAL ELECTION DAY!

The Calhoun County Election's Office encourages electors to get-out-and-vote on **TUESDAY, AUGUST 6, 2019** if you live in Clarence, Marengo or Sheridan Townships, and/or the Marshall District Library district (which includes the City of Marshall, Eckford and Marengo Townships, and portions of Fredonia and Marshall Townships that are in Marshall Public Schools district). The polls will open at 7:00a and will remain open until 8:00p.

**Clarence Township** electors will be voting on an Operating Millage Renewal of .02052 mills to renew and restore 1 mill allocation in perpetuity.

**Marengo Township** electors will be voting on a new additional 1 mill for 7 years for the purchase of fire protection motor vehicles including apparatus and equipment, and housing.

**Sheridan Township** electors will be voting on an increase of up to 1 mill for 3 years for local road repairs, upgrades, construction, improvement and maintenance purposes.

The **Marshall District Library** electors will be voting on a renewal not to exceed .6927 mill for 8 years to provide funds for all district library purposes.

Due to the passage of Proposal 18-3 many registration and absentee voting rules have changed ...

REGISTRATION: If you have been a resident at your current address since July 7, 2019 and are not a registered voter, you can still register with your local clerk and vote in this special election! (opportunities listed below)

ABSENTEE BALLOTS: All voters can now vote early (a reason for voting absentee is no longer required)!

**MONDAY, AUGUST 5<sup>th</sup>** - Your Local Clerk's office will be open to register electors with proof of residence, and to issue absentee ballots until 4:00p ... (contact your local clerk for available hours)

**TUESDAY, AUGUST 6<sup>th</sup>** - Your Local Clerk's office will be open to register electors between 7:00a and 8:00p. Only electors registering after 4:00p Monday can receive an absentee ballot in the Clerk's office on Election Day.
