

Information for AP Exams 2026

- AM Exam directions will be read starting at 7:45 Doors open at 7:30
- PM Exam directions will be read starting at 11:45 Doors open at 11:30

What Students Should Bring to the Exam

- Several sharpened No. 2 pencils with erasers (**NO MECHANICAL PENCILS**)
- Black or dark blue ballpoint pens
- If you are taking a digital or hybrid exam, you must bring your laptop AND laptop charger. You must know your College Board username and password to sign into Bluebook. You will not be able to take the test if you do not know your College Board username and password.
- Calculator for: AP Calc, Chem, Physics, Stat, Env Sci, Biology, Macro, Micro. (4 function calculator only for Macro and Micro – no graphing)
- A ruler for AP Physics
- Sweatshirt/sweater
- Water is permitted but must be kept under your desk while testing.

What Students Should Not Bring to the Exam

- Backpacks, pencil cases, purses
- Books, white-out pens, highlighters, notes
- Cell phones, smart watches and/or any other electronic devices
- Tissue packages or boxes

Exam Day Procedures

- Please leave all personal items in your car/home
- If students must bring bags, there will be space in the front of the testing room to store items
- Students will receive an email ahead of time from Total Registration with room assignments.
- Exams will start promptly at the designated time (8:00 am and 12:00 pm)
- Students will not be permitted to enter once an exam begins
- Students are not permitted to access materials, phones, or teachers during the break
- You are required to stay the entire length of an exam, no early dismissals
- Make arrangements for LUNCH. Make sure to bring a lunch if you have 2 exams on the same day or receive College Board approved accommodations and will be testing with a later end time.
- Talk with teachers ahead of time about missing class for exams

Emergency/Illness
