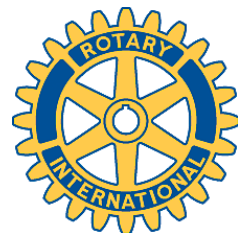

## Rotary Youth Exchange

Rotary Youth Exchange is a once in a lifetime opportunity for students to broaden their education and world understanding by letting them live with a Host Family and attend High School in a foreign country.

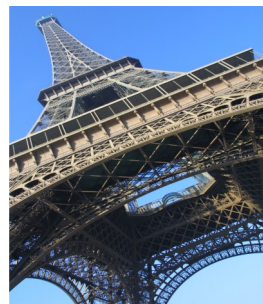
As a Rotary Youth Exchange Student, you will spend an academic year (long term program), or just four weeks (short term program) with a Host Family in a country other than your own. You may learn a new language; you will learn a new way of living and a great deal about yourself. While you are learning, the people you meet will be learning about your country, your culture and your ideas.

**YOU** will be helping to bring the world closer together and making friends that last a lifetime.

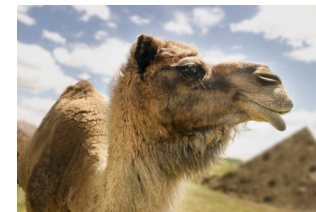


### Long Term (Full Year) Exchange

- The Hosting Rotary Club usually provides a monthly allowance of approximately \$100 US dollars. The Host Family provides the food and lodging.
- You are responsible for your airline ticket, visa and passports fees, application (\$750) and insurance costs (up to \$600.00), emergency fund of \$300.00 (to be replenished throughout the year as used), plus the cost of any additional travel or group trip that may be available during your exchange and additional spending money, etc.
- Your family agrees to personally host or assist in identifying an acceptable alternate host family for a student from another country for up to six months during your year abroad.
- Each applicant must be sponsored by a local Rotary Club in District 7450. The local club interviews the applicant and then sends the application to the District Youth Exchange Committee to schedule a District interview.
- Interviews are held October and November for the following year.



### Short Term (4-6 Weeks) Exchange



- The short term program last approximately four weeks.
- The U.S. student's family hosts a foreign student, then the U.S. Student is hosted by the foreign student's family.
- During the exchange the student is not permitted to have a summer job.
- Cost of travel, application fee (\$65), international health insurance policy (\$200) clothing and personal expenses are the responsibility of the participating students and their families.
- ESSEX arranges the exchange. You are responsible for arranging your travel plans in conjunction with the partner family, as dates of departure and arrival vary from country to country.
