Digital Submission requirements and information:

Due to current public gathering restrictions in effect, **submissions for this show will be online only. How to submit:**

- **MAKE SURE YOU TYPE YOUR INFORMATION CORRECTLY IN THE JOT FORM ONLINE**
- Click the link: <https://www.cordovacouncil.org/call-for-artists>
- Follow the prompts and click submit!
- You will receive an email telling which pieces to drop off and if you were in the previous show you will pick them up the old pieces at that time.

- This is a juried show. Juror TBA
- No entry fee. Please register as an artist on the Cordova Community Council Website. You must live or work in Rancho Cordova or have a current membership with Rancho Cordova Arts to enter.
- Size limit: minimum 12” on one side, and maximum 36’ Wide and 48” Tall and no more than 30 lbs.
- All submissions must be your own current and original artwork and **not previously shown at City Hall**
- Acceptable media: all media of two and three-dimensional artwork. 3-D must fit in the display case.
- **ALL 2D WORK MUST BE WIRED, FRAMED AND READY TO HANG.** No Sawtooth hanger. Improperly framed works will be declined at intake.
- Gallery-wrapped canvases must have painted sides, and no staples.
- Artist’s contact information will be made available for interested buyers; However, **all art will remain on display until the end of show.**
- All submitted work must include a completed tag provided below. Please attach to the back side of each submitted piece. **Completed tags are necessary. Please print clearly and make sure info is correct.**
- **All art pieces not picked up within 48 hours from the pickup dates noted below become the property of the Cordova Community Council unless arrangements have been made ahead of time.**



Wiring 2D Art

With Rancho Cordova City Hall's art installation system, 2D artwork hangs best if wired as shown below.

- Place hanger (D-rings preferred) NO LOWER THAN $\frac{1}{4}$ down from top of frame. Screw these into the inside sides of picture frame or canvas frame structure.
- For metal frames, place wire hardware NO LOWER THAN $\frac{1}{3}$ down from top of frame.
- IF YOU WIRE IS PLACED FURTHER THAN $\frac{1}{3}$ FROM THE TOP, YOUR PIECE WILL HANG UNSUCCESSFULLY FROM ANY WALL HANGING SYSTEM.
- Be sure that wire is not so loose as to stretch beyond the top of your frame.



And remember - no saw tooth hangers.
