Limelight Panicle Hydrangeas

FEATURED PLANT: PANICLE HYDRANGEA

Panicle hydrangeas (Hydrangea paniculata) are tough shrubs that bloom profusely from July-September when few other shrubs are blooming. They thrive in full sun and tolerate drought and urban conditions better than other hydrangeas. The blooms make long-lasting cut flowers!

Some common cultivars are 'Limelight', 'Little Lime', 'Pinky Winky' and 'Pee Gee'.

COMPLETED TASKS

- Irrigation start-up and inspection (Apr-May)
- Spring annual flower installation (delayed to week of May 9)
- Warm-season turf fertilizer application - 1 of 3 (May)
- Pruning, supplemental watering, and weed control will be performed as needed

UPCOMING TASKS

- Warm-season turf fertilizer application - 2 of 3 (Jul/Aug)
- Fungicide on fescue turf (Jul/Aug)
- Flower maintenance
- Check and maintain irrigation system
- Pruning, supplemental watering, and weed control will be performed as needed

Please note: the townhomes and villas will have weekly service throughout Jul/Aug.
