**FEATURED PLANT:
CAMELLIA JAPONICA**

There are numerous species of camellia, about 250; one type is Sasanqua, which blooms in the fall, and the other is Japonica, which blooms in the late winter to early spring. Camellia Japonica is the prominent species of the genus and has 30,000 cultivars with various bloom colors and sizes. Even when the camellia is not in bloom, they look amazing in the landscape with dark green shiny foliage that remains year-round. Camellias look great in containers, along wood lines or as a specimen shrub in the landscape. These camellia are typically 6-12' tall, but always check the tag since there are many different varieties of these plants to choose from.
