UPCOMING TASKS

- Leaf clean up
- Winter bed prep
- Mulch application for parks and service areas
- Pre-emergent for warm season turf late feb
- Spot spraying weeds
- Tree limb up in all parks

Service Areas will receive one visit in January for Mulching and routine maintenance and then one visit in February for routine maintenance and pre-emergent application
