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Actions You Can Take

There are personal and societal actions we can take. Choose a couple of actions from this list:

Establish or join a group in town or at your place of worship whose purpose is to educate ourselves about Reparations, and to take action to promote racial and economic equality.

- Learn about your local NAACP chapter. Go to a meeting. Bring a friend.
- Attend lectures, movies, and events concerning people of color. Read Black literature. Watch Black movies.
- Say "I'm sorry" once in a while (context depending)
- JOIN and give SUPPORT to N'COBRA-PHL
- Ask your college/university alma mater and/or your employer about their policies on Reparations, and WHETHER colleges and universities IN YOUR STATE have acknowledged their INVOLVEMENT, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, IN THE SYSTEM OF "CHATTEL SLAVERY IN THE UNITED STATES.
- Query your state and local officials about revising school curricula to include history of DESCENDANTS OF AFRICANS ENSLAVED IN THE UNITED STATES(DAEUS), especially in K-12 Education.
- Become familiar with THE "SCIENCE OF REPARATIONS" with a balanced approach for engaging the historical units of Government, Colleges & Universities, Financial Institutions, and Historical Faith Communities. Encourage your local and state representatives to stand up for reparations.
